






Bolts M8x15MM (1)


- I.Ensure all parts have been removed from the carton and place on a protected surface or carpet.
 - 2. Check all parts and hardware are the same as the "Parts List".
 - 3.Attach Leg Panel (2) to Shelves (1) as below image. Please ensure the assembly hole on Leg panel are on the same side.
 - 4.Connect Shelves (I) & Leg Panels (2) by using Bolt (A) with Washer (C) and Spring Washer (B) by using Allen Key (D). Note: Please do not fully tighten all Bolts until the bookcase is fully assembled.



Connect Cross Rail (3) with Bolt (A), Washer (C) and Spring Washer (B) by using Allen Key (D). Note: Please do not fully tighten all Bolts until the bookcase is fully assembled.



Place the Bookcase onto a flat level surface and level the frame, Once the Bookcase is level, tighten all Bolt (A) with Allen Key (D).



Periodically (every 90 days) make sure that the screws are still fully tightened. **ATTENTION**: Be certain that all screws are fully tightened before using Bookcase.

WE STRONGLY RECOMMEND TO ATTACH THIS UNIT TO THE WALL TO PREVENT TOPPLE. KEEP YOUR PRODUCT SAFE FROM INJURY.

Wall straps are already pre-assembled on your Furniture.

Assembly Steps to attach your furniture to a wall:


- 1. Use a pencil to mark the fixing positions on the wall
- 2. Drill holes and insert appropriate wall plugs into wall (not provided)
- 3. Place the product against the wall, ensure the strap is under the top panel
- 4. Secure wall strap to the wall with appropriate screws for your wall type (not provided). Tighten with screwdriver.

Warning:

- I. Please note this item needs to be fixed on to the wall to prevent falling forward when product is in use.
- 2. Always ensure intended wall area to be drilled is free from hidden electrical wires, water and gas pipes.



Limited Warranty

In the event of a defect in material or workmanship covered by this warranty, the manufacturer will repair or replace, at their discretion, without charge the warrantied parts within a reasonable amount of time. We reserve the right to require damaged parts to be returned to us upon request. Natural markings such as scars, brands, grain variations, wrinkles, color variations, etc. will be considered normal characteristics and not construed as defects.
