



## Quality starts with a vision

Many companies have great looking furniture, but looks aren't everything, and they're certainly not enough. It's what's on the inside that counts. Furnishings are an investment, a big, long-term investment and just like with any investment, you can make a good one or a bad one. We're proud of our quality story, it's one of the biggest things that sets us apart, and above.

### Our solid wood...

More than ever, being environmentally conscience and responsible, is a part of our lives. Manufacturing process, waste management, use of natural resources and more affect after our quality of life. We recognize that home furnishings too have a positive or negative impact on our environment. For this reason, as well as the sheer beauty and quality of our wood, over 95% of all our products are proudly crafted in Parawood. An extremely dense plantation grown hardwood. Parawood is the tree in which latex is produced (often referred to us rubberwood). For approximately 10+ years the tree is tapped to extract the latex, much the same manner syrup is tapped from a maple tree. At that average time the tree naturally ceases to produce latex and is cut down for manufacturing of furniture. For every tree cut, a new tree is planted as a replacement, harmoniously maintaining natural balance.

Parawood beyond the bark: Scientific name - Hevea Brasiliensis, Density - 7+ (similar or Birch or Ash), Strength group - B6 (same as maple). All this making it one of the most widely used hard woods in home furnishings and a very durable hardwood.

### Our finish...

It's what sets us apart. We use pre-catalyzed clear conversion coatings. Our coatings are non-yellowing HAP's free (hazardous air pollutants), while offering outstanding UV resistance. All our coatings have undergone rigorous quality testing to verify performance and application characteristics. We received highest resistance ratings against the following household chemicals: Vinegar, Juices, Ketchup, Olive Oil, Hot/Cold Water, Nail Polish Remover, Ammonia, Alcohol, Windex, Lysol, 409, Coffee, Wine, among others. While no natural wood product/finish is indestructible we do recommend the following tips for care and extended life: cleaning is easy – a damp cloth is all that's needed, avoid placing your furniture in direct sunlight for extended amounts of time, avoid placing your furniture very near heating vents or wood burning stoves, and lastly we do recommend using placemats and/or table mats for further protection.

### Our tables feature...

- Reinforced Corner Block Bolts with 1/2" bolts & locking nuts/washers for maximum stability.
- Folding Leaf Hinges to enable the leaf to store flat as well as add leaf apron protection.
- Apron Stabilizers to ensure strength and stability of the table.
- Metal Ball Bearing Extension Glides (instead of other standard wood gear extensions) to make for a seamless, a smooth transition from smaller to larger dining.
- Gap Covers to ensure that aprons are continuous and allow for minor table expansion due to drastic climate changes.
- Self Storing Butterfly Leaf (Leaves) to save space.

### Our chairs feature...

- Leg Stretchers to ensure chair legs do not loosen from strenuous and everyday use.  
*\*Leg Stretchers are both glued and screwed in place.*
- Solid Wood Construction (all parts and components)
- Reinforced Corner Block Bolts with 1/4" bolts & locking nuts/washers for maximum stability.  
*\*Custom Finished Chairs are equipped with metal glides and leveled ensuring stability.*  
*\*Custom upholstery seat options are all manufactured in the U.S.*

- Full extension metal glides
- English and French dovetail drawers
- Solid wood construction

### Our commitment...

All of our furniture is guaranteed for one year against all manufacturing defects. All damages such as scratches, gashed, broken corners, and finish or fabric imperfections must be reported within 30 days from the date of delivery.

### Care...

- Sunlight is one of nature's elements that can cause damaging effects to your new furniture. It is preferable not to expose your furniture to direct sunlight for long periods of time and to leave your table leaf extensions in place as to ensure the uniform aging of your finish.
- Our finishes take up to 21 days after the delivery date to fully cure. Prior to this date, use your furniture with care.
- Cleaning is easy – a damp cloth is all you need. For everyday use, we recommend using fabric placemats, trivets with FELT protectors, and table pads to protect against scratches, dings or dents and immediately wiping away any spilled liquids.
- Avoid putting extremely hot or cold objects in direct contact with a wood surface. Extreme temperatures can cause discoloration to the wood finish and may cause permanent and irreparable damage.
