



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Please carefully unpack each of the components and hardware.
 check the components against the parts list and make sure there are no missing parts. lay pieces on cardboard or a soft mat to help protect the pieces from scratches.




Watch for sharp edges when handling the pieces, wear gloves to avoid injury.

STEP 01 Slide Foot Cover c onto the bottom of Post A . Attach Foot Base B to Post A with one (1) M5x25 Bolt [AA] on each side. Slide the Foot Cover c down to cover the Foot Base B . Repeat this process to make three (3) more posts.

- •For ease of assembly, it is recommended to have 3 or more people and allow enough time to completely finish the assembly. assembly can take 6-8 hours. a step-ladder is required for assembly (not included).
- •Follow step by step instructions, and follow all safety warnings provided with your tools.
- DO NOT tighten screws until all the screws and washers are properly installed.
 tighten screws securely, do not over tighten.
- •Gazebo should not be used in inclement weather and high winds.


STEP 02 Connect Cross Beam 1 1 1 to Cross Beam 2 1 2 using two (2) M8x8 Four Claw Screw Nuts [KK] on the front side, and two (2) M8x25 Bolts [GG] and two (2) M8 Flat Washers [MM] on the other side. Repeat this process to make three (3) more assemblies.






STEP 03 Insert two (2) M8x8 Four Claw Screw Nuts [KK] into the front side of Cross Beam 3 on both ends. Repeat on the other three (3) assemblies.

Insert two (2) M8x8 Four Claw Screw Nuts [KK] into the holes on the back of all Cross Beam 4s D4 and Cross Beam 5s D5






STEP 04 Attach one (1) Cross Beam 5 05 to each end of Cross Beam 3 03 using one (1) M8x25 Bolt [GG] and one (1) M8 Flat Washer [MM] per hole. Repeat to make another assembly.

Attach one (1) Cross Beam 4 124 to each end of Cross Beam 3 123 using one (1) M8x25 Bolt [GG] and one (1) M8 Flat Washer [MM] per hole. Repeat to make another assembly.

STEP 05 Lay the Cross Beam D1 + D2 assembly from step 2 flat. Lay the Cross Beam D4 + D3 + D4 assembly from step 4 on top. Attach the two together with fourteen (14) M5x40 Screws [BB]. Repeat to make another side panel assembly.




STEP 06 Lay the Cross Beam D1 + D2 assembly from step 2 flat. Lay the Cross Beam D5 + D3 + D5 assembly from step 4 on top. Attach the two together with fourteen (14) M5x40 Screws [BB]. Repeat to make another side panel assembly.


STEP 07 Attach Cross Beam assembly D5 from step 6 to two (2) Posts A . Position the side with Cross Beam 1 D1 on the left. Attach using one (1) M10x80 Bolts [DD], one (1) M10x205 Bolts [HH], three (3) M10 Flat Washers [NN] and one (1) M10 Anti-Slip Screw Nuts [JJ] on one end. Repeat with the other end.

Repeat the entire process to make the other side of the gazebo.




STEP 08 Attach the Cross Beam D4 assembly from step 5 between the two sides of the gazebo made in step 7.


Position the side with Cross Beam 1 on the left. Attach using one (1) M10x80 Bolts [DD], one (1) M10x205 Bolts [HH], three (3) M10 Flat Washers [NN] and one (1) M10 Anti-Slip Screw Nuts [JJ] on one end. Repeat with the other end.

Repeat with the other Cross Beam D4 assembly from step 5.


STEP 09 Facing one side of the gazebo, attach Support Bracket 1 to the Post A on the left and Support Bracket 2 to the Post [A] on the right using two (2) M8 Flat Washer [MM] and M8x35 Bolts [CC] for the bottom holes. Attach the Support Brackets to the Cross Beams using two (2) M8 Flat Washers [MM] and two (2) M8x35 Bolts [WW]. Repeat with the rest of Support Bracket 1 and Support Bracket 2 2.




STEP 10 Attach one (1) Connector 1 M1 on top of each Post A using eight (8) M5x25 Bolts [AA]. Make sure the top of the connector is pointing into the gazebo.




STEP 11 Attach one (1) Roof Rib 1 1 to each Connector using one (1) M6x20 Bolt [EE] and one (1) M6 Flat Washer [LL] on each side.







STEP 12 Connect four (4) Roof Top Borders together using one (1) M6x20 Bolt [EE] STEP 13 Attach one Roof Rib 2 2 into each corner of the assembly from the last step. Use and one (1) M6 Flat Washer [LL] in each hole.




STEP 15 Attach the entire assembly from the last step to the top of the gazebo's Roof Rib 1s using one (1) M6x20 Bolt [EE] and one (1) M6 Flat Washer [LL] on each side.





<u>STEP 16</u> Attach one Connector 2 <u>M2</u> to the bottom of one (1) Middle Cross Beam with the wings pointing toward the hooked end. Repeat three (3) more times to finish all four cross-beam assemblies.

<u>STEP 17</u> Attach Middle Cross Beams from step 16 to the gazebo from the middle of each side to the roof top assembly. Use two (2) M6x20 Bolts [EE] and two (2) M6 Flat Washers [LL].




<u>STEP 18</u> Attach one (1) Roof Support 3 between each set of Roof Rib 2s 2 at the top of the gazebo.

STEP 19 Attach two (2) Roof Support 1s 11 to each side of the gazebo in the lowest set of holes in the roof ribs and middle cross beams.




STEP 20 Attach two (2) Roof Support 2s **J2** to each side of the gazebo in the middle set of holes in the roof ribs and middle cross beams.


STEP 21 On each side of the gazebo, attach one (1) Roof Border 1 K1 on the left and one (1) Roof Border 2 K2 on the right along the bottom of the roof.





STEP 22 Secure the Roof Borders K1 and K2 at the center with one (1)
Connector 2 placed over the middle cross beam and attached with four (4) M5x25
Bolts [AA].




STEP 23 Facing a side of the gazebo, attach one (1) Mosquito Net Rod 1 H1 on the left and one (1) Mosquito Net Rod 2 H2 on the right. Connect them to the connectors at the corner and center of each side using M6x20 Bolts [EE] and M6 Flat Washers [LL].









STEP27 Build the roof by installing the Roof Plates in this order from left to right: Roof Plate P1 , Roof Plate P3 , Roof Plate P3 , Roof Plate P2 , Roof Plate P2 , Roof Plate P2 , Roof Plate P2 . Use one (1) M6x20 Bolt [EE] and one (1) M6 Flat Washer [LL] per hole. Repeat on all four sides of the gazebo.






STEP 29 Insert two (2) Concrete Anchors [UU] into each Foot Base and bolt to the ground. Ensure bolts are fully tightened to the ground. Slide the Foot Cover back into place at the bottom of the post.




Outdoor Structure anchoring guide for anchoring gazebo to wood or concrete: If step 29, on page 12 in the assembly instructions is not properly completed, this will void the warranty.



WARNING! If your gazebo is not properly anchored, damage could occur. It is highly recommended for maximum safety that you mount and secure to wood or concrete footers. This is far better and safer than using ground stakes. The following are some examples of how to mount the structure to wood or concrete surfaces. Refer to local building codes or consider consulting a licensed contractor for assistance in the anchoring of this product.





If digging for foundation, please double check for possibility of any underground utilities such as gas, telephone,cable or sprinkler lines. Refer to your local building and city codes,ordinances,neighborhood covenants, or height restrictions regarding this type of structure for guidance on acceptable installation requirements.
