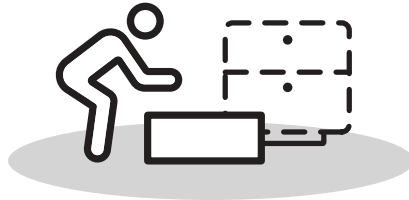
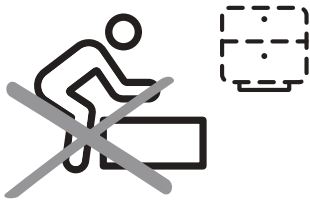
PRE ASSEMBLY INTRODUCTION

We understand building ready-to-assemble furniture can be a challenging experience for some. To help avoid confusion, we have provided some helpful tips that may speed up the process.



Teamwork

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.



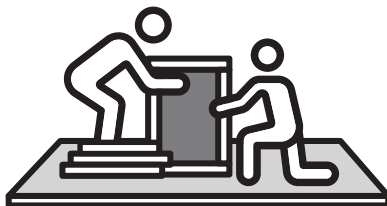
Suitable Location

Assembling near the area of the intended location is highly recommended.



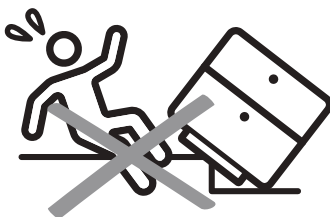
Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.



Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent to prevent scratches and damages.



Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

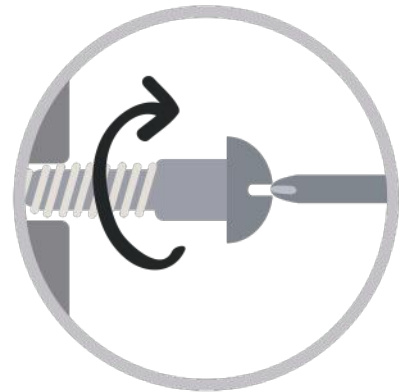
ASSEMBLY AND CARE ADVICE

Position each part correctly
and insert screws or bolts into
their respective holes.



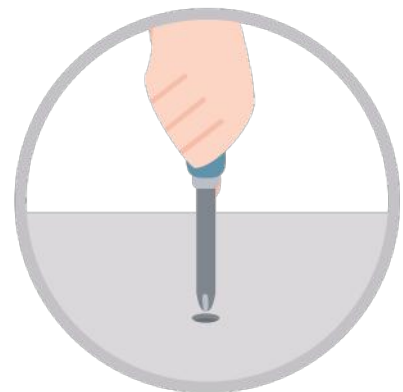
Turn clockwise to tighten and
only tighten when step is
completed or when instructed
to do so.



Use the appropriate hand tools
or power tools for assembly.
Select steps, such as tightening
screws and/or bolts, may require
hand tools to avoid causing
damage during assembly.



Save the instructions and store
any supplied tools for later
maintenance.



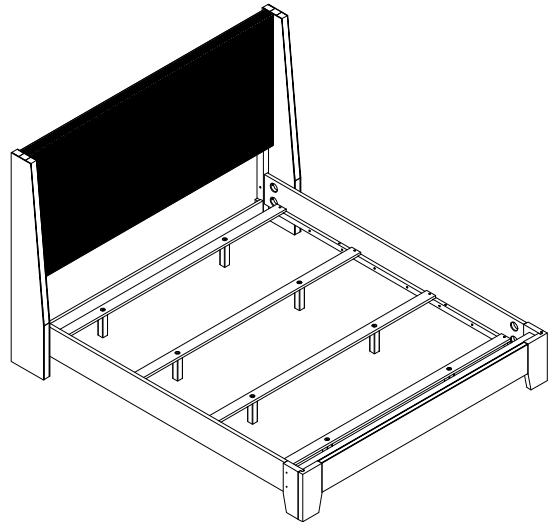
After two weeks, check and
tighten any loose hardware and
repeat again every six months
thereafter.

Note : Left and right is determined by facing the front of the headboard in its upright position.



STEP-1

1. Prepare 8 bolt assemblies by applying a lock washer (#C) onto the bolt (#B) then a flat washer (#D) onto the same bolt (#B).
2. Carefully place the headboard (#1) onto the top of the H/board legs (#2). Insert 4 bolt assemblies into each end of the legs (#2) and secure using the Allen wrench (#E).

STEP-2

1. Insert two dowels (#F) into each end of the legs support (#3), then insert other ends into the left and right headboard leg (#2)
2. Insert a bolt (#A) with lock washer (#C) and flat washer (#D) into the inner holes. Secure Using the Allen wrench (#E).

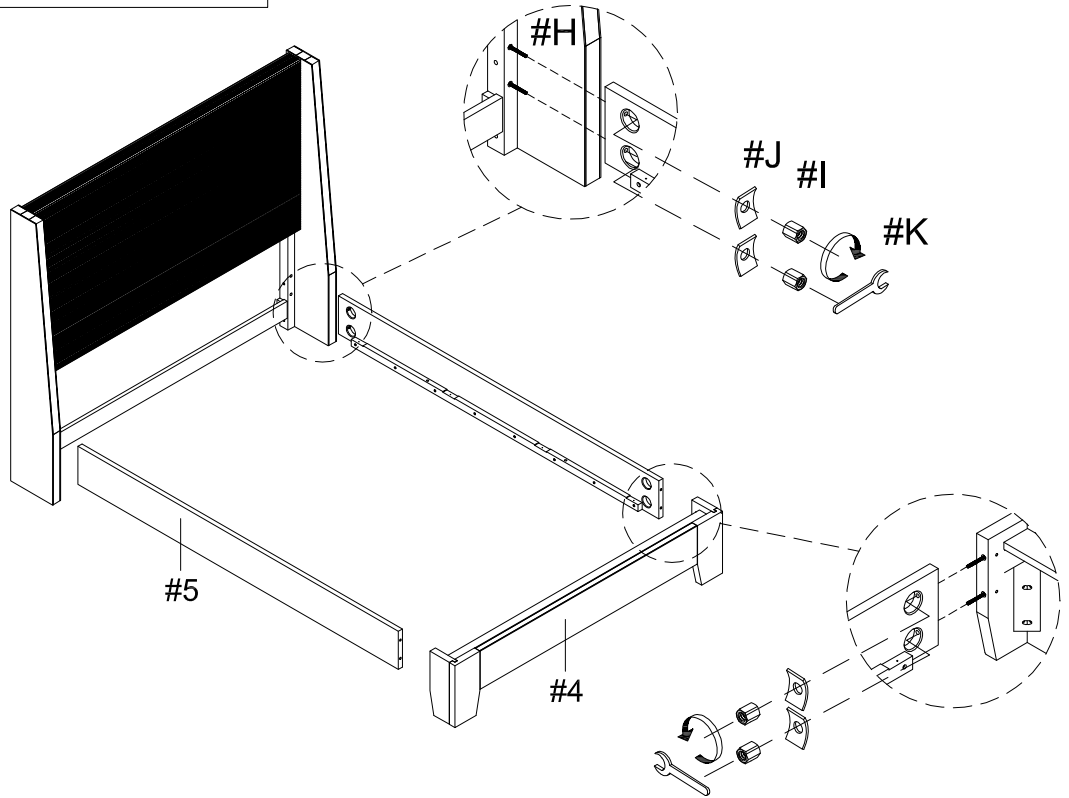

1. Insert 2 threaded studs (#H) into the holes along the sides of the headboard (#1) and footboard (#4). Turn right to tighten

2. Apply the each end of the side rails (#5) onto those threaded studs (#H).

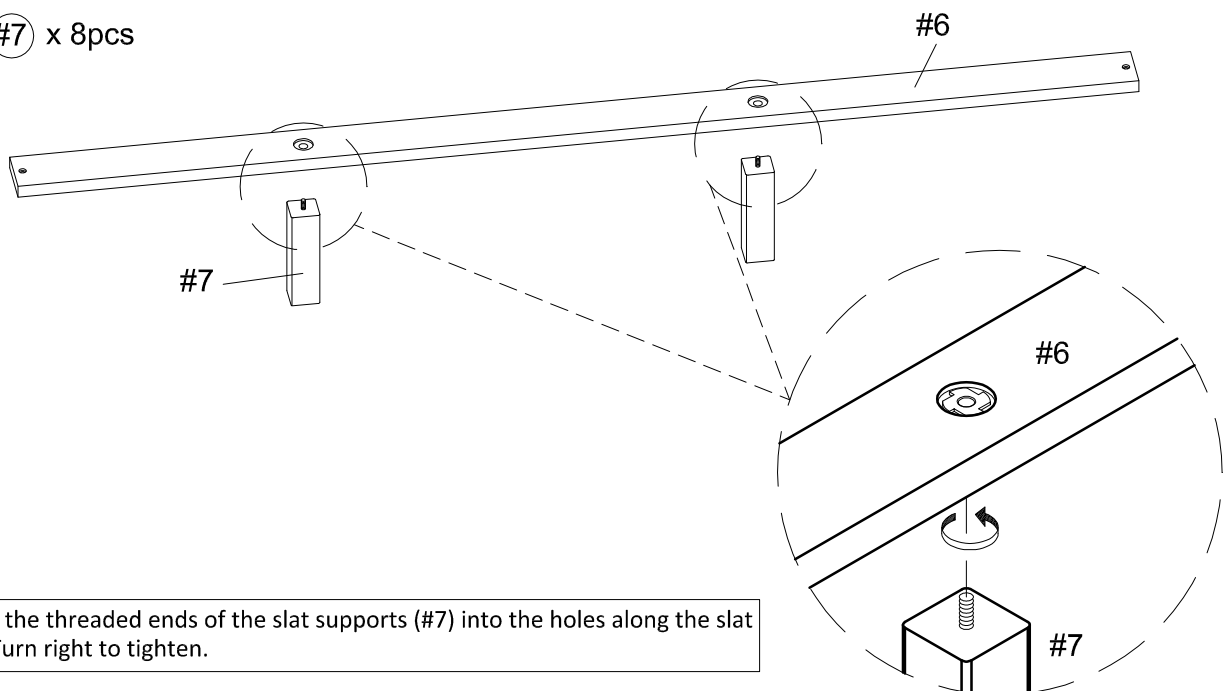
3. Apply a hex nut (#I) then a beveled washer (#J) onto the threaded studs (#H). secure the washer using the wrench (#K).

Part #6 x 4pcs

1. Insert the threaded ends of the slat supports (#7) into the holes along the slat (#6). Turn right to tighten.

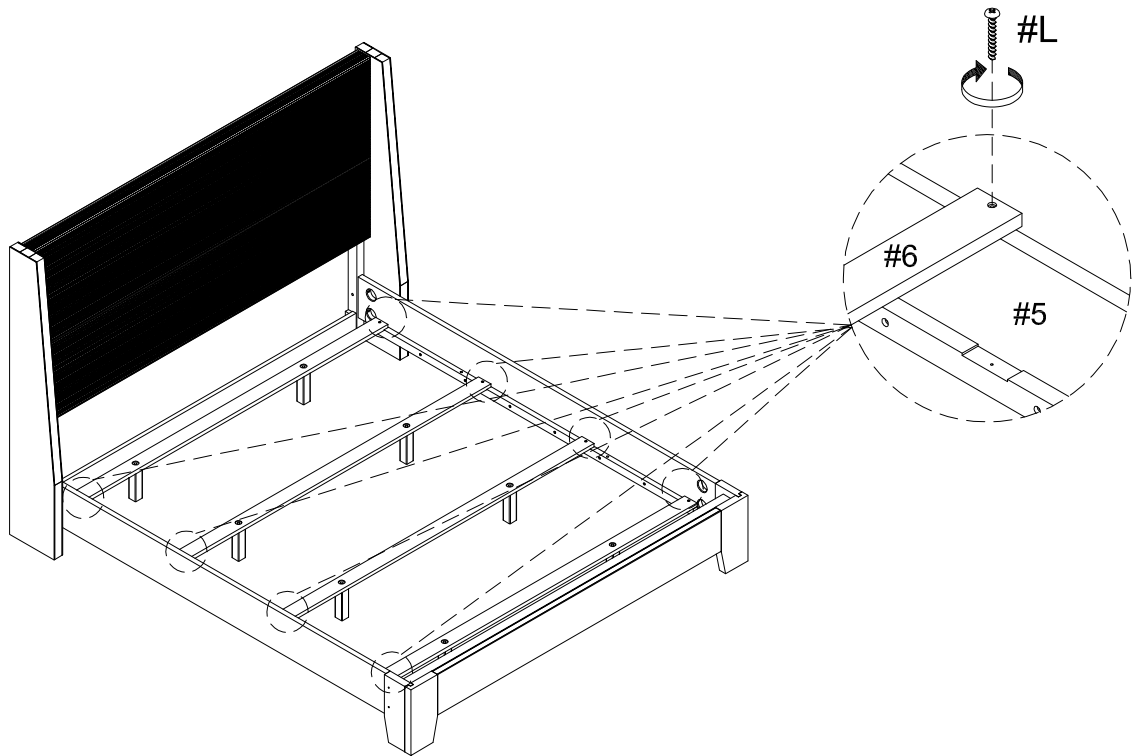

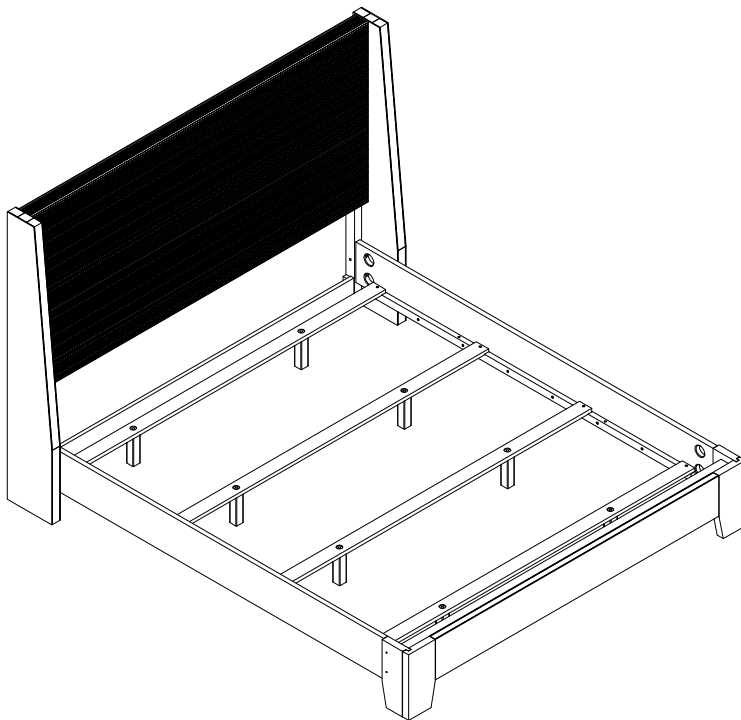
Hardware #L

1. Apply the slats (#6) onto the side rails (#5).

2. Insert a screw (#L) into the ends of the slats (#6). Secure using the Philips screwdriver.
