DO NOT DAMAGE THE INSULATION OF OLDER WIRING. In regular circumstances the BLACK wire will be the "Hot" lead and the WHITE wire will be the "Neutral" or "Common" lead. A GREEN or BARE COPPER wire is the "Ground". In older buildings it is always good practice to reconfirm the polarity of the wiring.

- This fixture is designed to be mounted on a correctly installed on 1/2-13 threaded rod secured to structure and standard round or octagon box or a through wiring box with a plaster frame. The box must be securely mounted to the structure of the building. The crossbar and hardware supplied should be used. Directly mounting the fixture to the outlet box may make it impossible to correctly align the fixture.
- This fixture is supplied with a 16ft. aircraft cable. This feature allows the fixture to be mounted with a stem up to 14ft. in height.

FIXTURE PREPARATION

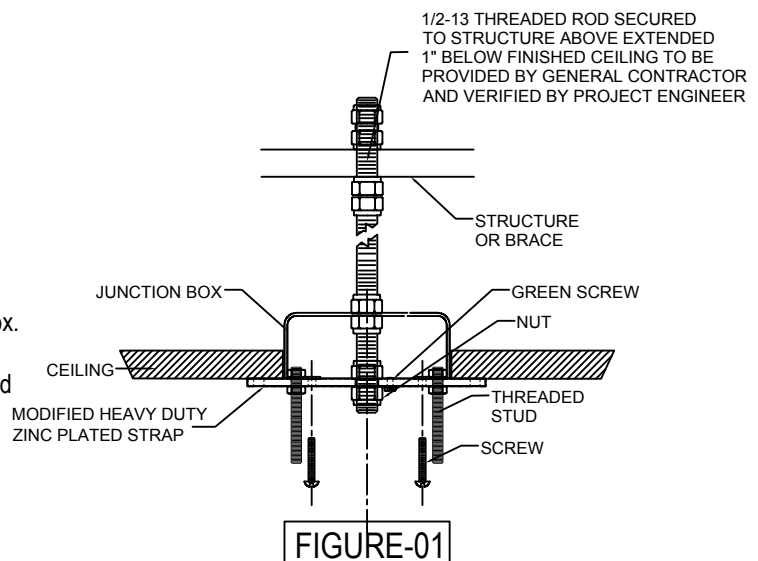
1. Remove the fixture, parts and parts bag(s) from the carton.

NOTICE:

- Before discarding the carton, double check to make certain that all parts are found.

FIXTURE INSTALLATION

1. Attach the modified heavy duty zinc plated strap to the junction box. (The green screw should face the floor). Place the modified heavy duty zinc plated strap at the junction box and fasten using the round head screw then fasten the 1/2-13 threaded rod with the corresponding nuts. See FIGURE-01.



- Determine the overall desired length of the fixture. Insert cables on the cable grip attached on the canopy.

- Strip the coaxial cable about 2", exposing 2 wires (braided wire & white wire). See FIGURE-02.
- Separate the two wires and tangle the braided wire. See FIGURE-03.
- Strip the White Wire by 1/2" as well as to the Braided Wire. See FIGURE-04.
- Insert the LED Drivers unto the studs of canopy and secure it by tightening the hex nut.
- For DC Wire Connection:
 Connect the coaxial cables unto their respective LED Drivers (See Wiring Diagram)
 Fasten the white wire of coaxial cable unto the red wire of the LED Driver.
 Fasten the wires together with an approved fastener (wire nut). Starting about 1" below the fastener, tightly wrap the connection with electrical tape so that the connections seals the end of the fastener. See FIGURE-05.
- Connect the braided wire of coaxial cable to the black wire of LED Driver.
 Fasten the joined wires as in step 7.
- For AC Wire Connection:
 Both LED Driver's white lead are fasten to the white wire in the outlet box.
 Fasten the wires together with an approved fastener (wire nut). Starting about 1" below the fastener, tightly wrap the connection with electrical tape so that the connections seals the end of the fastener. See FIGURE-05.
- Both LED Driver's black lead are connected to the black wire in the outlet box.
 Fasten the joined wires as in step 9. See FIGURE-06.

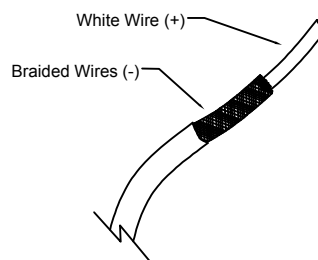

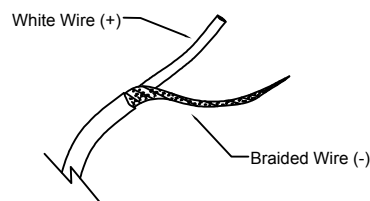

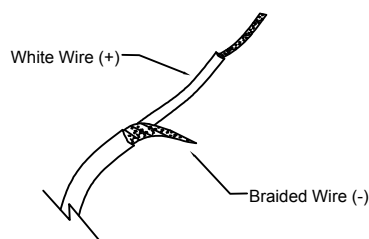

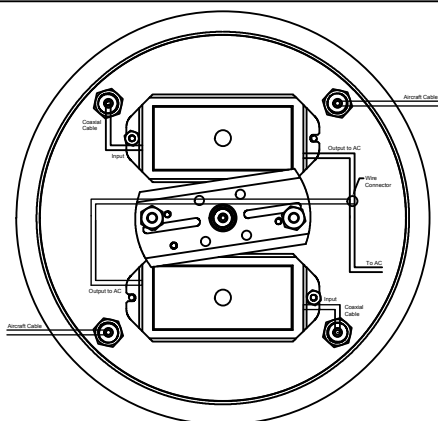

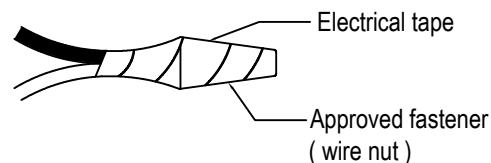

13. Pull up & attach the canopy to the mounting strap and secure it with Center Lock Up.
(See Figure-06)

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14. To level the fixture or change the drop height based on your desire height, push the tab down on the grip lock either pull or push the aircraft cable. Repeat this to all aircraft and coaxial cable until the fixture is level and with the desired height. See FIGURE-07.
16. Restore power to the circuit breaker or fuse box.

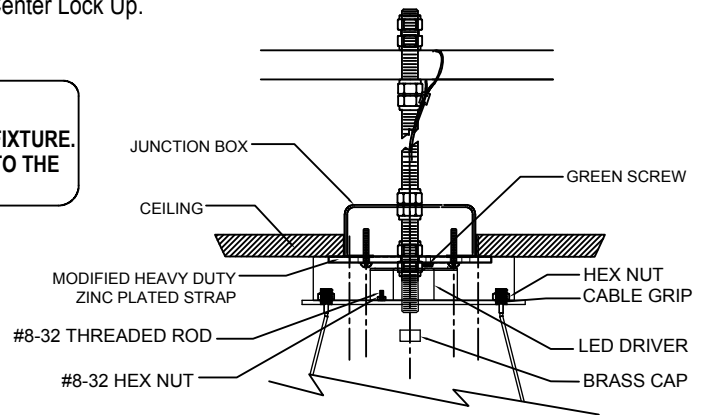

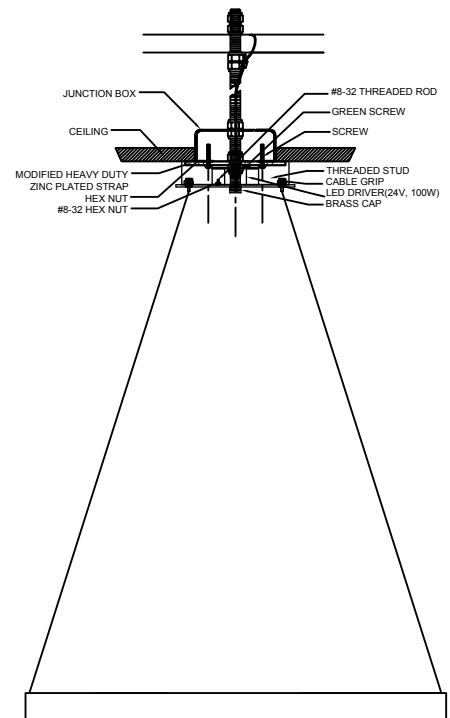
