















We recommend that two adults work together to assemble this table.

Tighten all bolts on legs assembly.





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Step 5:

Note: set the rods into the right position according to the artwork.

The players of each team should be right-side up, facing their opponent's goal, follow the diagram below for proper rod placement

Slide one end of the player rods (#1, #2, #3) through the main cabinet according to the diagram below to identify where the two, three, and five player rods go in the cabinet.

Player rod assembly:

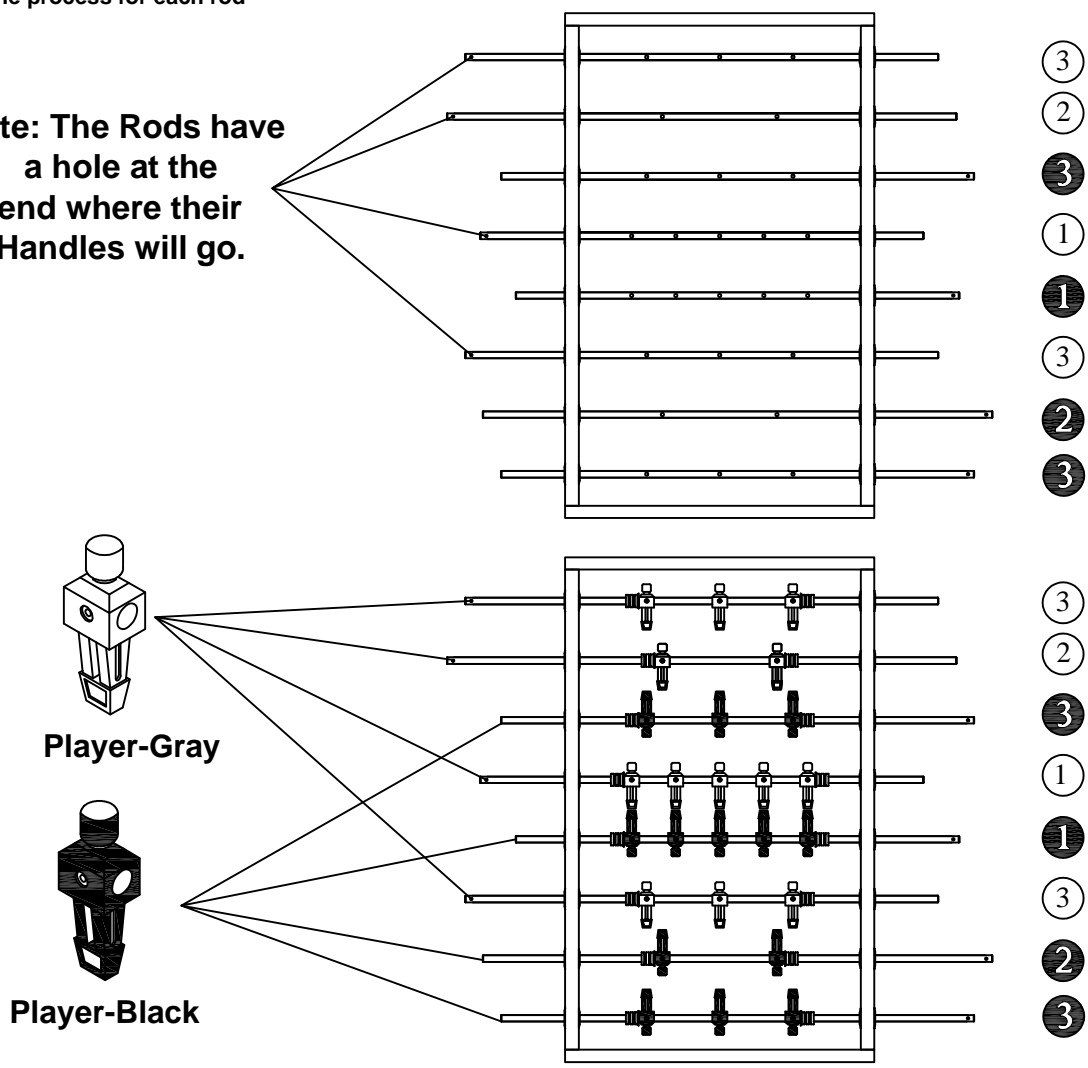
Place one #6 bumper & one #7 washer on the rod

Place the appropriate number of Attach #4 and #5 players to the rod #1 and #rod2 rod #3.

Using #10 bolt and #11 nut Place one #7 washer & one #6 bumper on the other end of rod. Slide the rods through the other end of the cabinet

Repeat the process for each rod

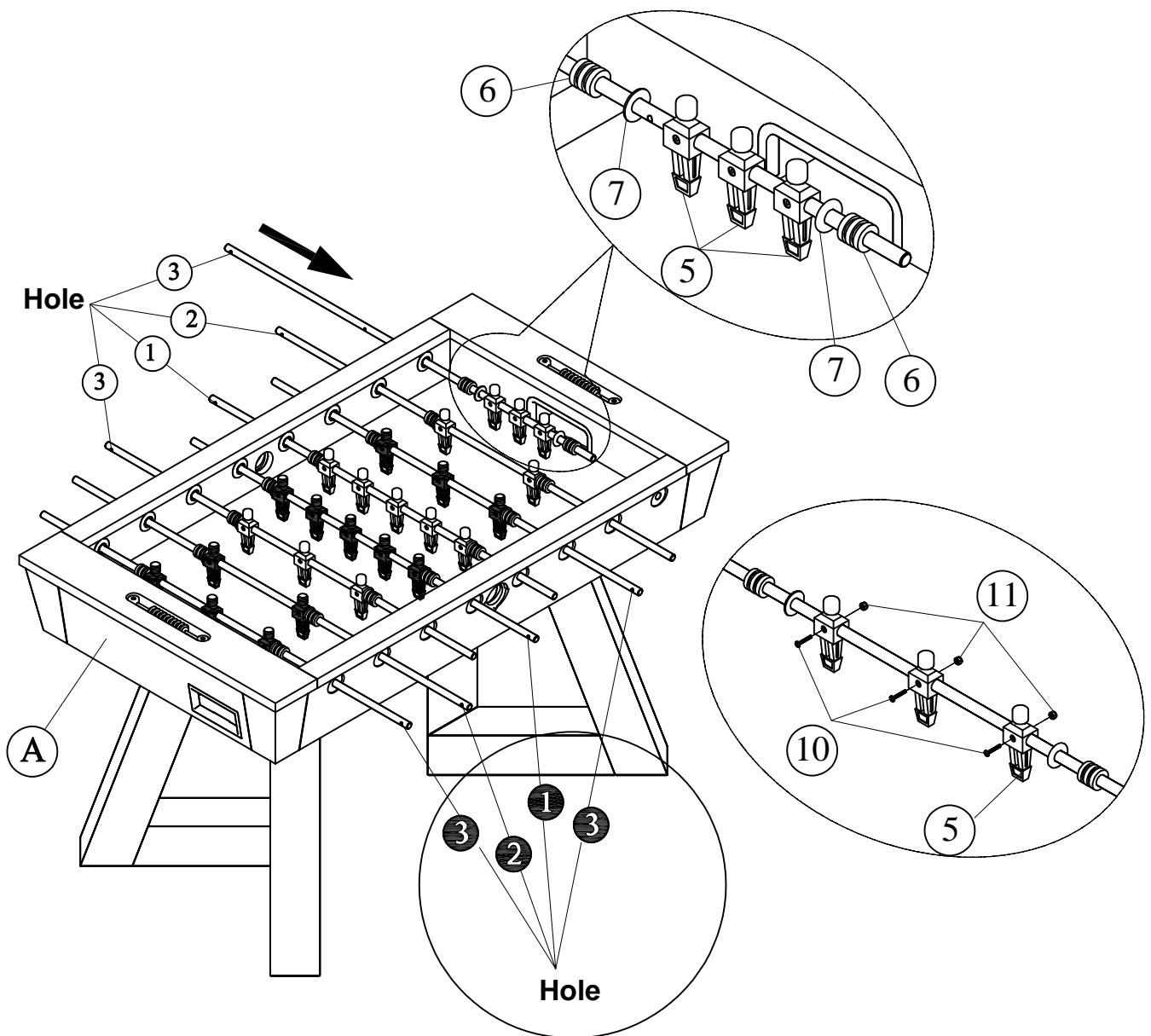
Note: The Rods have a hole at the end where their Handles will go.
