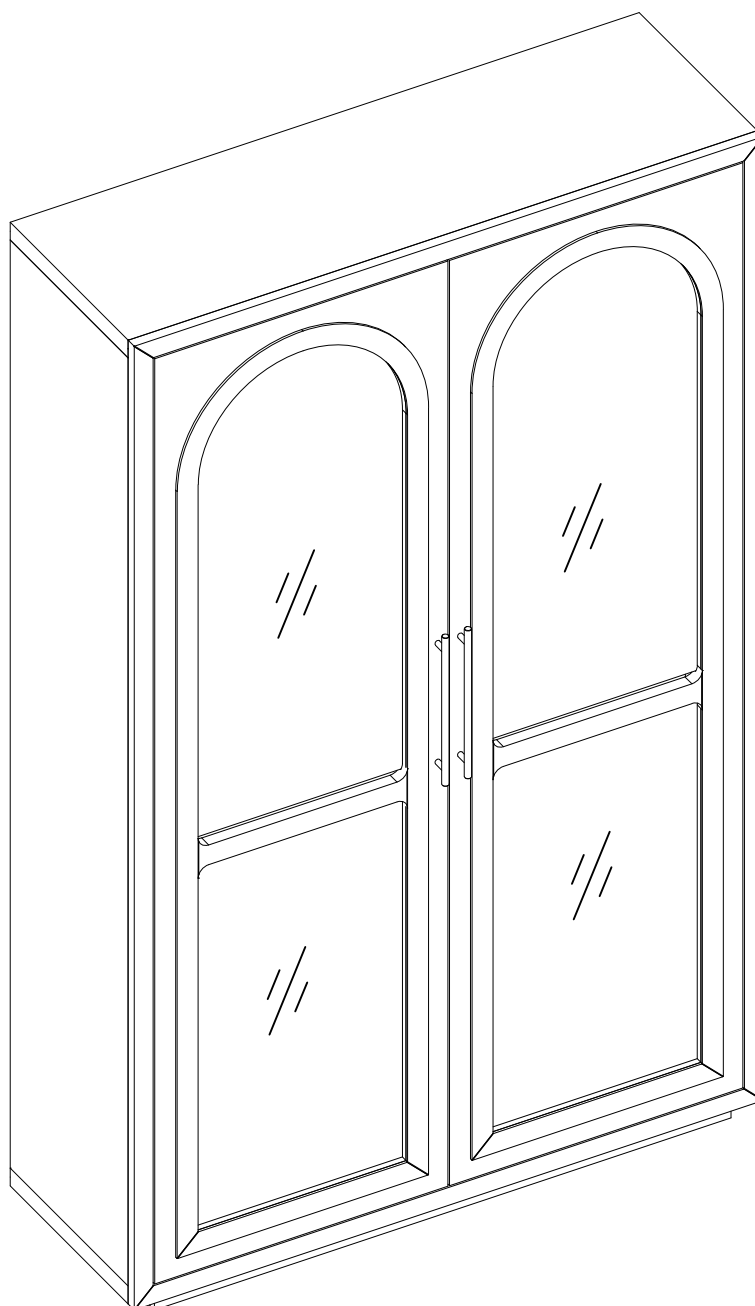

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# Before You Start

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## Overview

1. Check and ensure you have received all packages and necessary parts.
2. Prepare adequate assembly space. We recommend using pads or cardboard to prevent the floor from scratches.

### Solid Wood

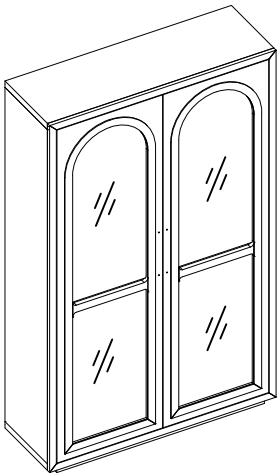

Each marble and engineered stone piece has a unique pattern. Due to the nature of the materials, the pattern may differ from the one you see when purchasing.

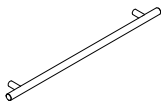

## Exploded Views



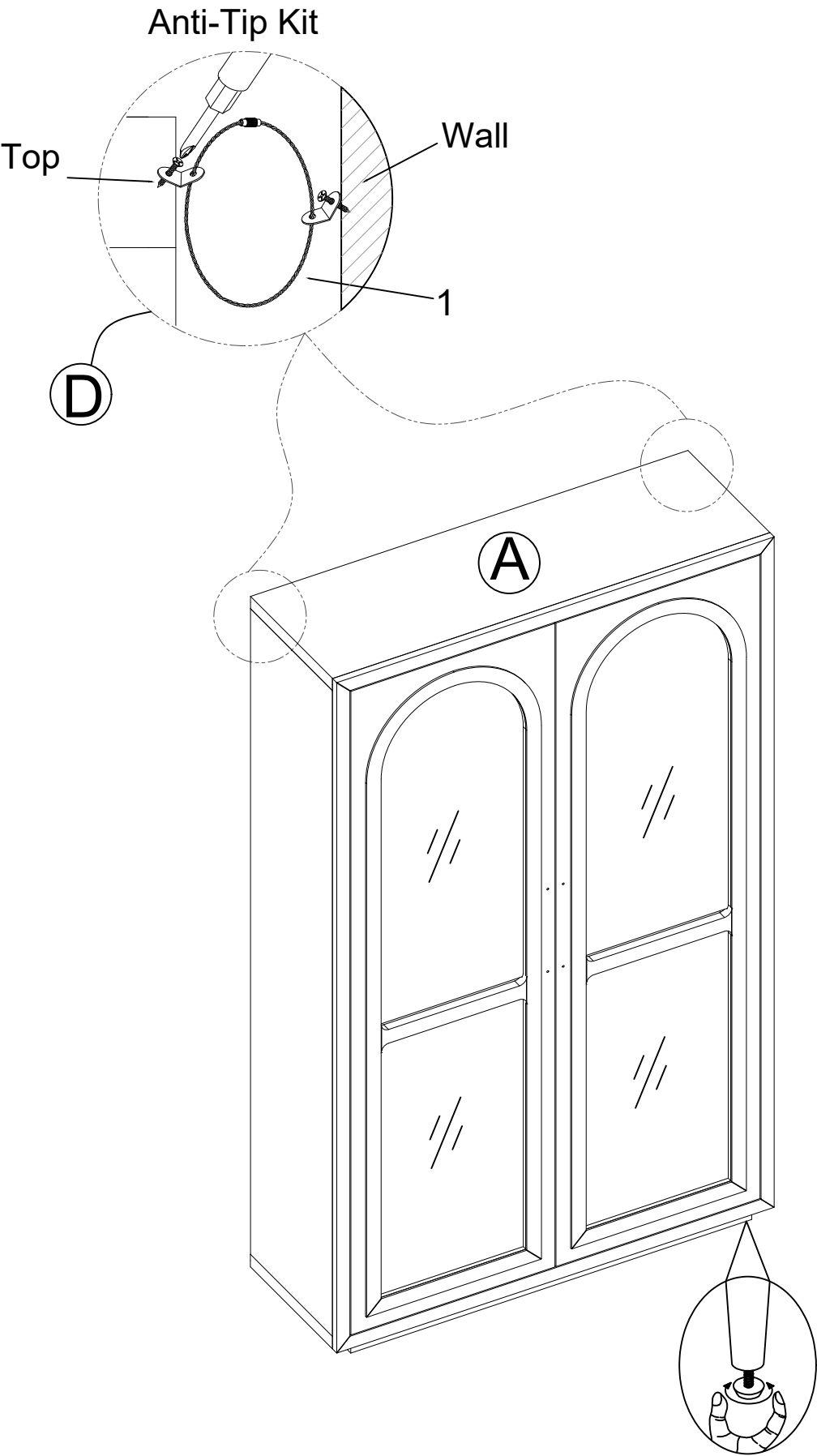

### SAFETY WALL STRAP INSTALLATION

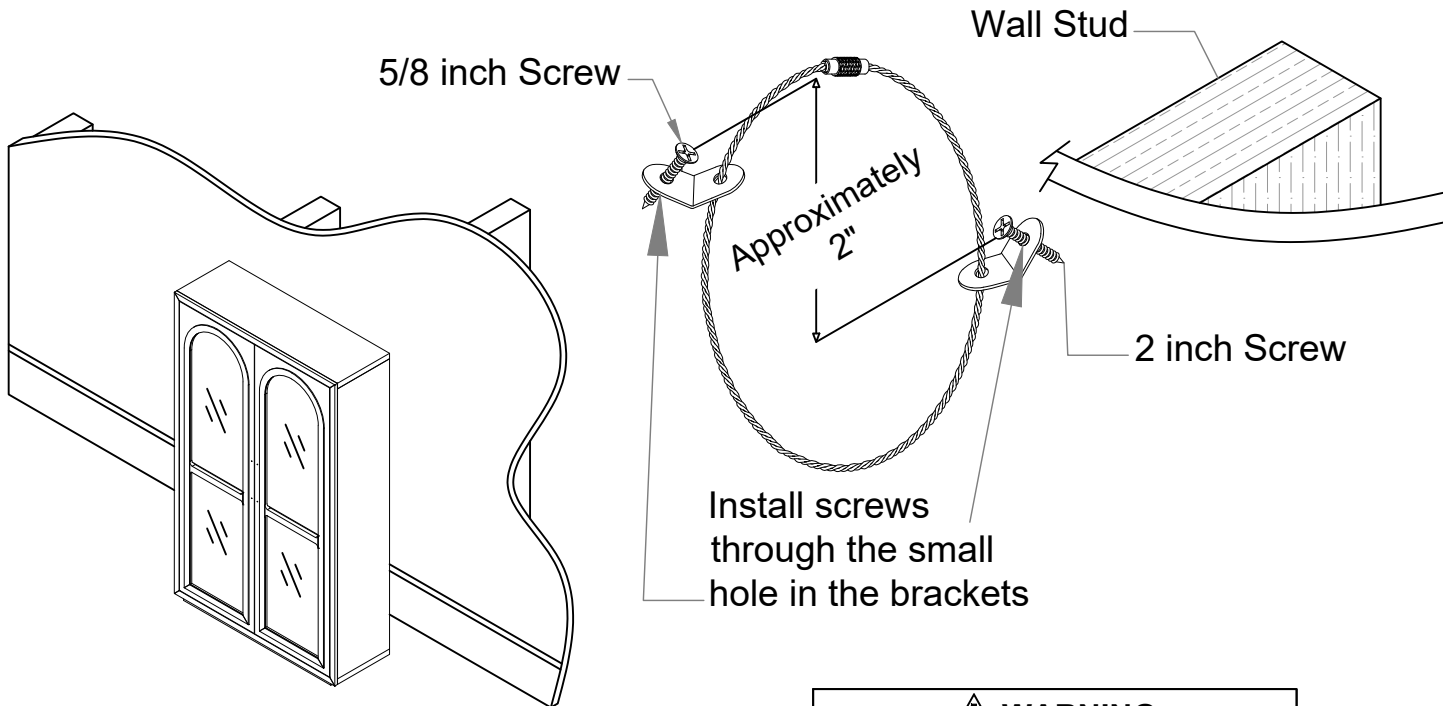
Note: It is highly recommended to install this safety strap kit to prevent tipping, damage and/or injury.

1. Insert short screw (C) through Double hole iron sheet (B) and safety wall strap (E) and attach to top panel (part A) using philips head screwdriver.

2. Drill a 11/32" hole where you want to secure the unit. The drilled hole will be at the same height as the hole in top panel (part A) where the safety wall strap (E) is attached. Tap wall anchor (A) into the hole.

3. Insert long screw (D) through Double hole iron sheet (B) and safety wall strap (E) into wall anchor (A) using philipshead screwdriver.

Note: This item is not intended for clothing storage use.

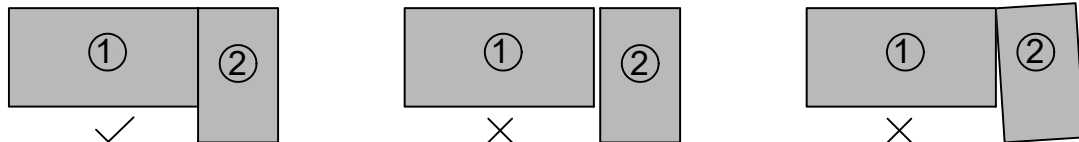

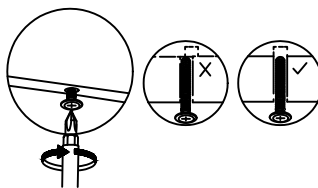
| Product Category | Fault                        | Cause Analysis                                                                             | Handling Method                                                                                               |

| Wood furniture   | Door opening is not flexible | The furniture is not leveled                                                               | Use items to level the furniture                                                                              |
|                  |                              | The door hinges should be adjusted properly.                                               | Adjust door hinges and apply lubricating oil.                                                                 |
|                  | Inflexible opening of drawer | Overload or deformation                                                                    | Reduce weight, adjust guide rails, lubricate                                                                  |
|                  | Loose component connection   | Loose hinges or screws                                                                     | The poke part should be coated with an appropriate amount of 502 glue, then re-install or tighten the screws. |
|                  | Minor scratches              | friction with hard o sharp objects                                                         | Use a brush to apply similar pigment ink along wood grain to the scratches, then wipe off the excess.         |
|                  | Corrosive stains             | Accidentally stained with chemical solvents such as nail polish, nail polish remover, ect. | Wipe them with a dry cotton cloth immediately                                                                 |

## Possible Issues During Assembly:

- The two boards can't be aligned at he same level.

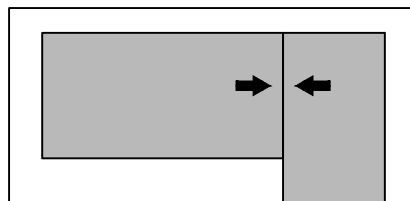


- Holes on the bards and poles are not aligned, so screws can't be installed.



## Recommended Solution:

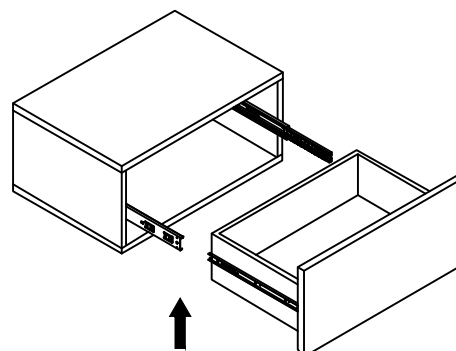
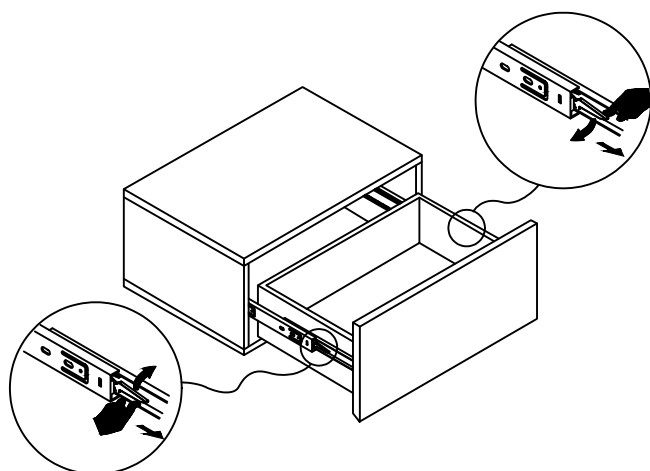
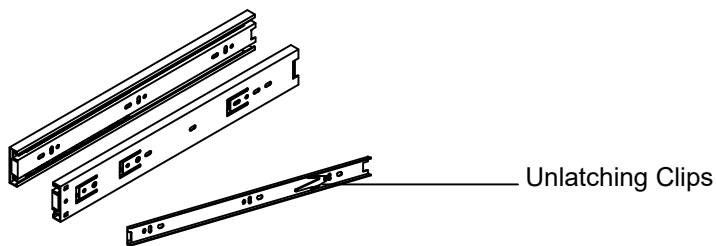
- Please sightly loosen all screws and adjust the bards. Because the diameter of the holes on the pipes 23 mm lager than that of bots, the position of the boards can be adjusted.



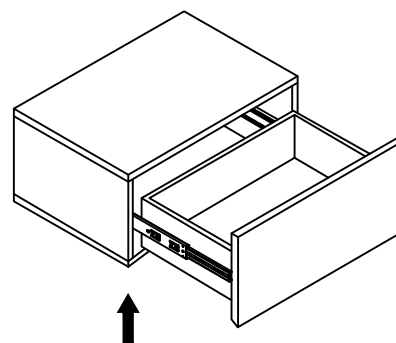
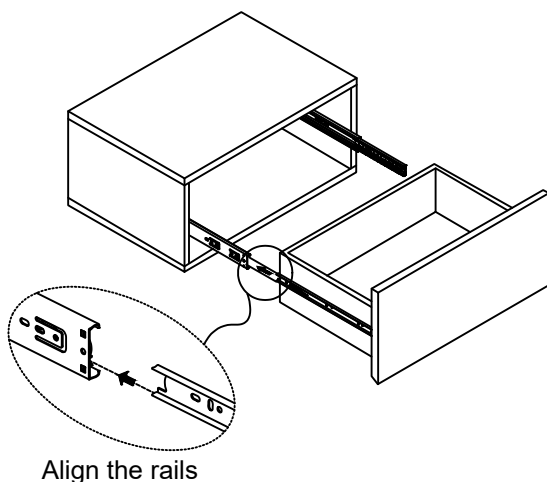

# Three-section Side-mounted Rail

## Part I Disassembly and Assembly Instructions



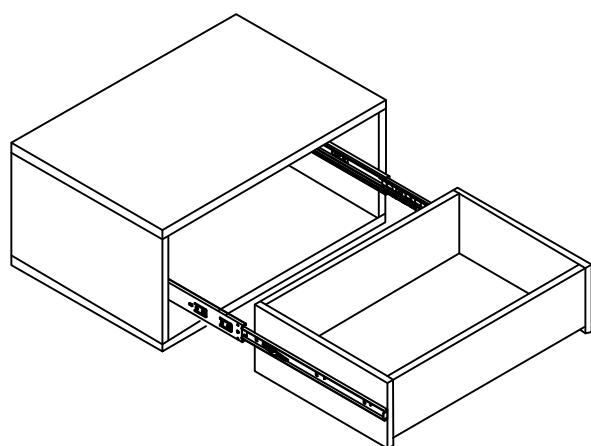
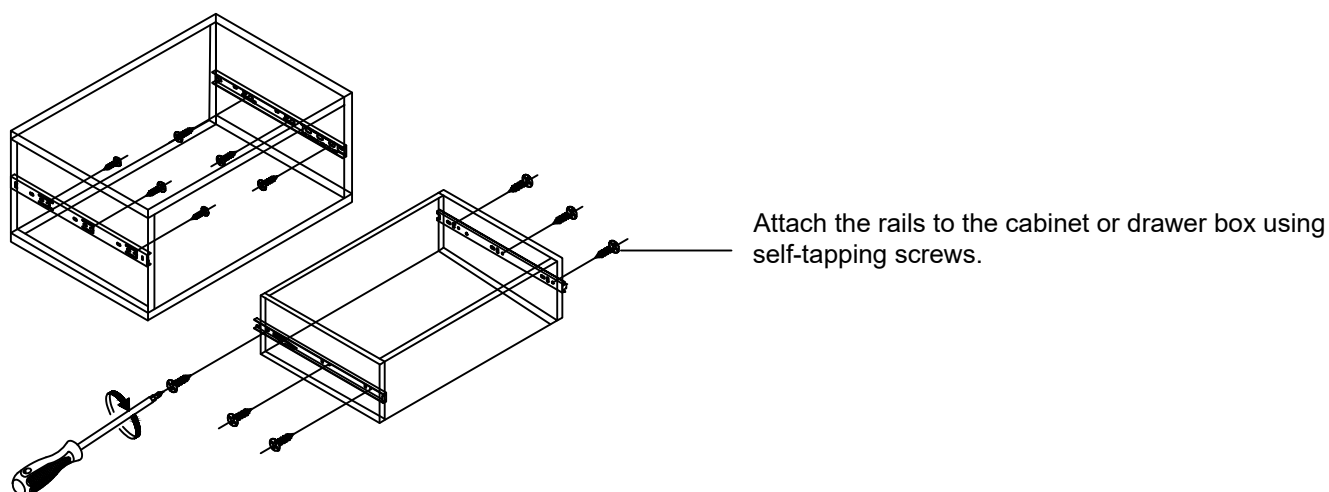
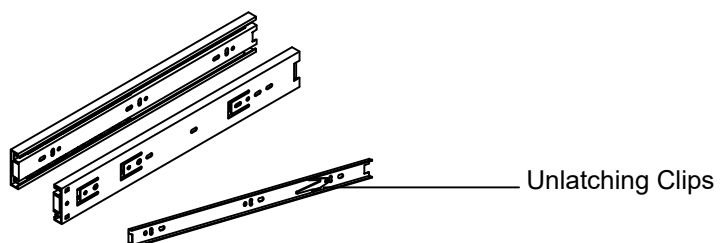
### Drawer Assembly:



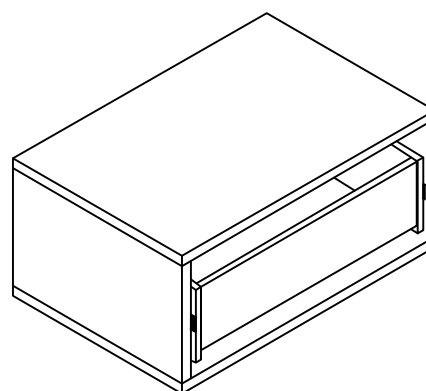
- Align and properly mate the two rail components on the drawer, push the drawer forward into the rails until it reaches the back.
- Repeatedly (2-4 times) push and pull the drawer to check if it slides smoothly. If not, disassemble the drawer and re-install.

## Part II Assembly Instructions

Press down the unlatching clips to separate the rail into two parts.

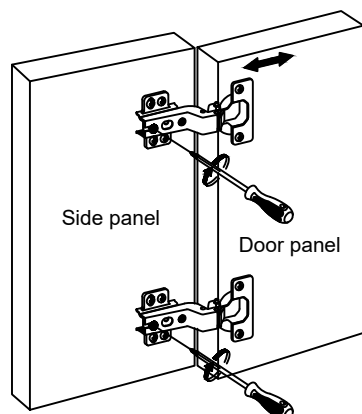


Align and properly mate the two rail components on the drawer, push the drawer forward into the rails until it reaches the back.



Repeatedly (2-4 times) push and pull the drawer to check if it slides smoothly. If not, disassemble the drawer and repeat step 3 to re-install.

# Door Panel Adjustment Instruction

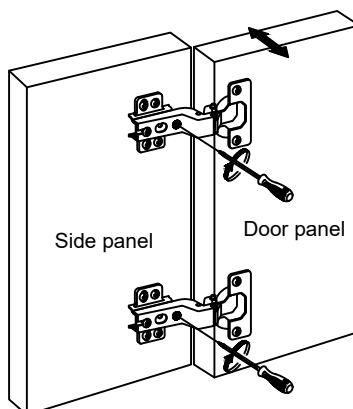

## Front-to-Back Direction Adjustment:

Rotate the screws on the door hinges shown in the image. The door panel can be moved front-back.

Adjustment range: 4mm

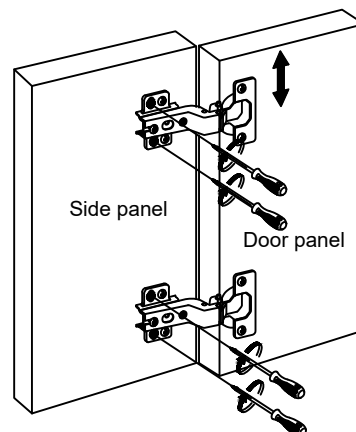

## Left-Right Direction Adjustment:

Rotate the screws on the door hinges shown in the image. The door panel can be moved left-right.

Adjustment range: 3mm

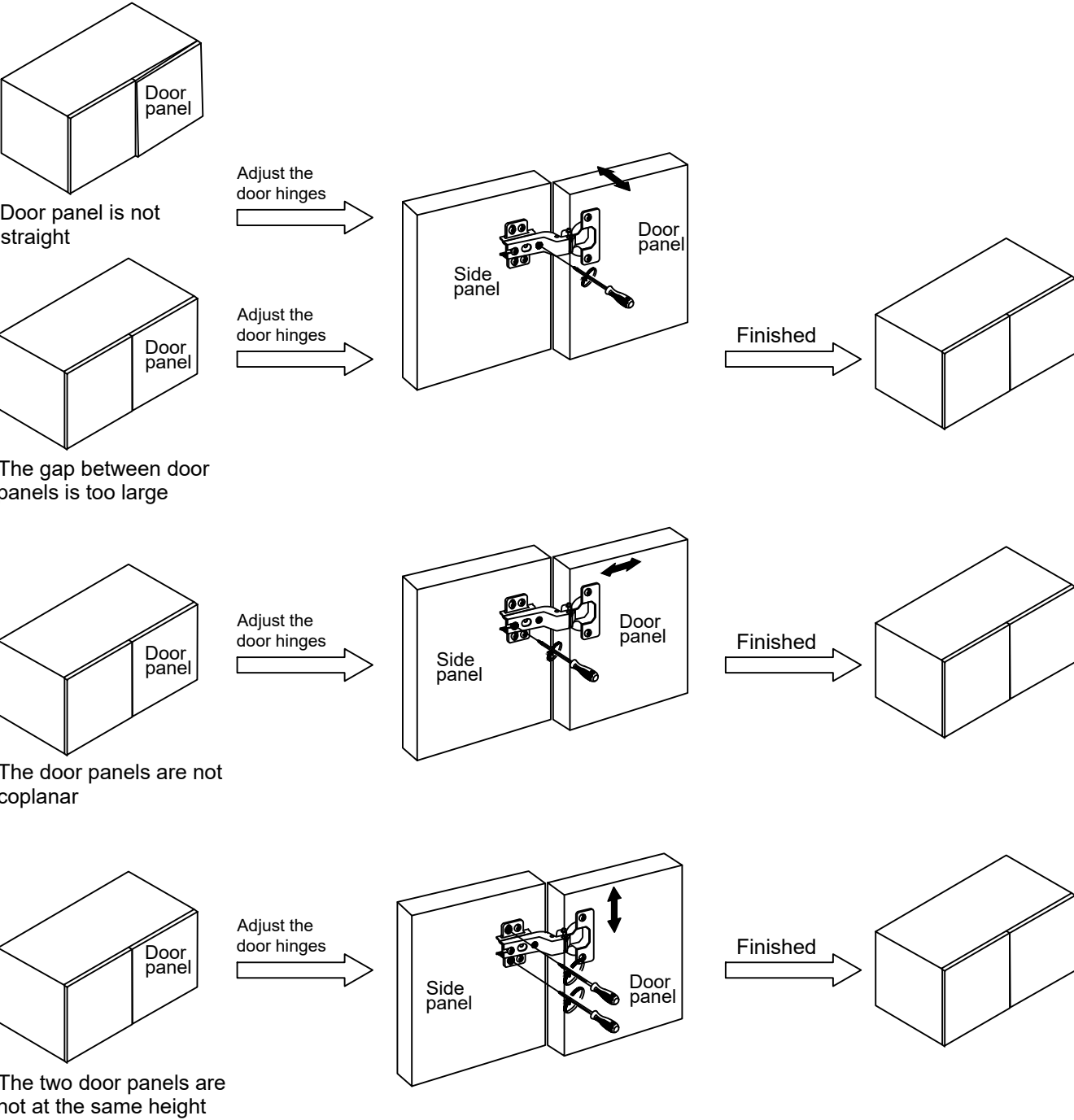
## Up-Down Direction Adjustment:

Rotate the screws on the door hinges shown in the image. The door panel can be moved up-down.

Adjustment range: 4mm

# Usage and Maintenance

---

## Use and Care

- Leave it vacant for half a month before use, maintain good ventilation to eliminate any odor.
- Place items steadily, heavier items should be placed at the bottom to avoid tipping over. For high temperature or frozen items, please put a heat-resistant pad underneath.
- Do not directly push or drag hard objects on the furniture to avoid scratching the surface.
- Avoid prolonged exposure to sunlight or heat sources to prevent discoloration or fading.
- Pay attention to moisture prevention to avoid mold. Keep the furniture placed steadily to prevent breakage or loosening.
- Please educate children to stay away from the glass sharp corners of the furniture.
- When opening and closing doors or drawers, handle them gently and check the screws regularly to tighten them.
- Use a soft dry cloth to dust, a slightly damp cloth to clean the surface, avoid abrasive cleaners.
