Care & Maintenance



● Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



● Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



● Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



● To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.



● Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



● Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



● To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.



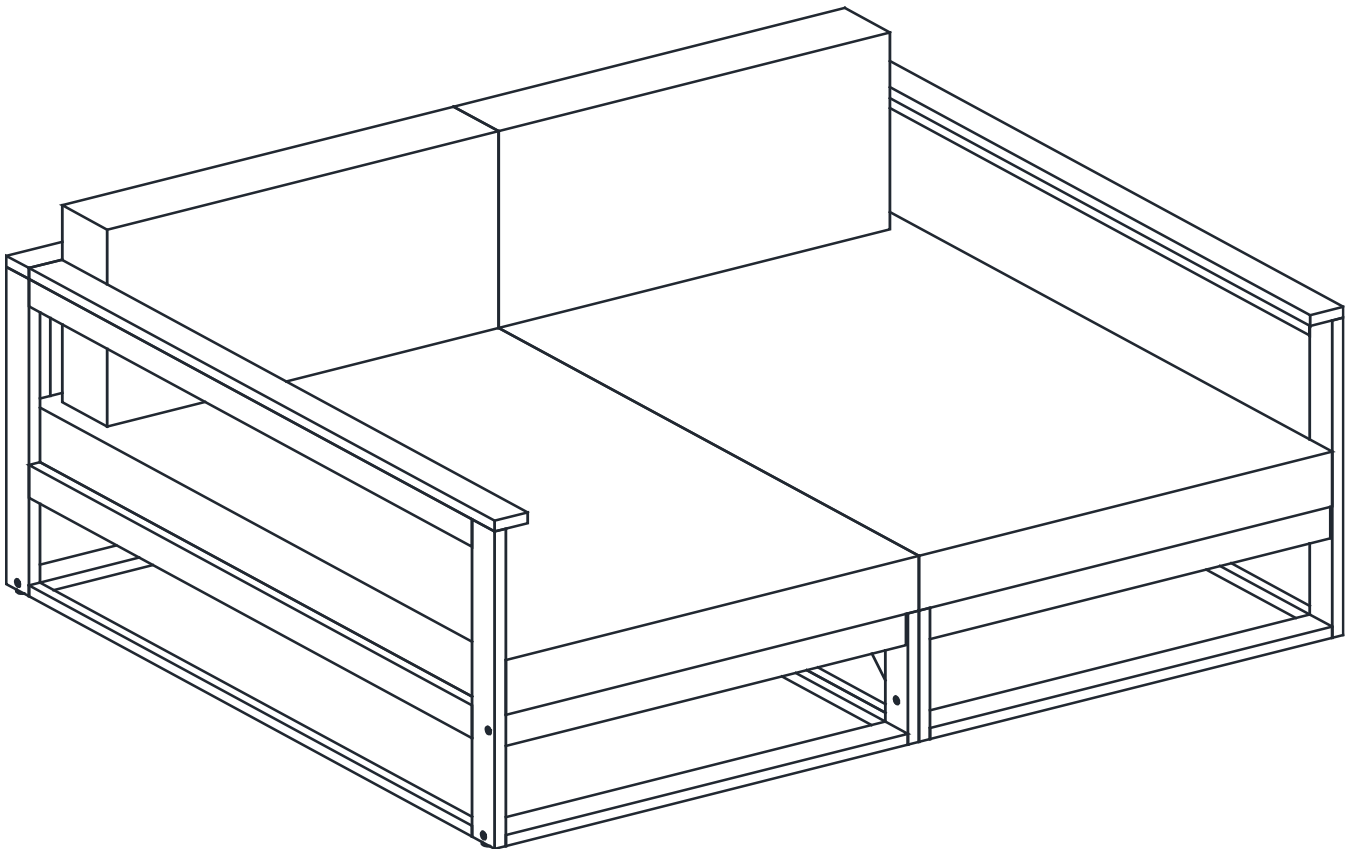
● Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.

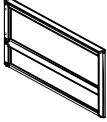
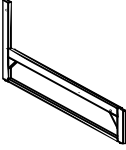
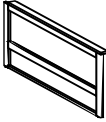
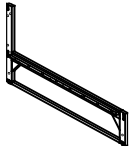
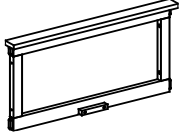
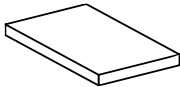
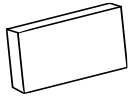
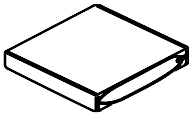


CAUTION: This DayBed is NOT a TOY.

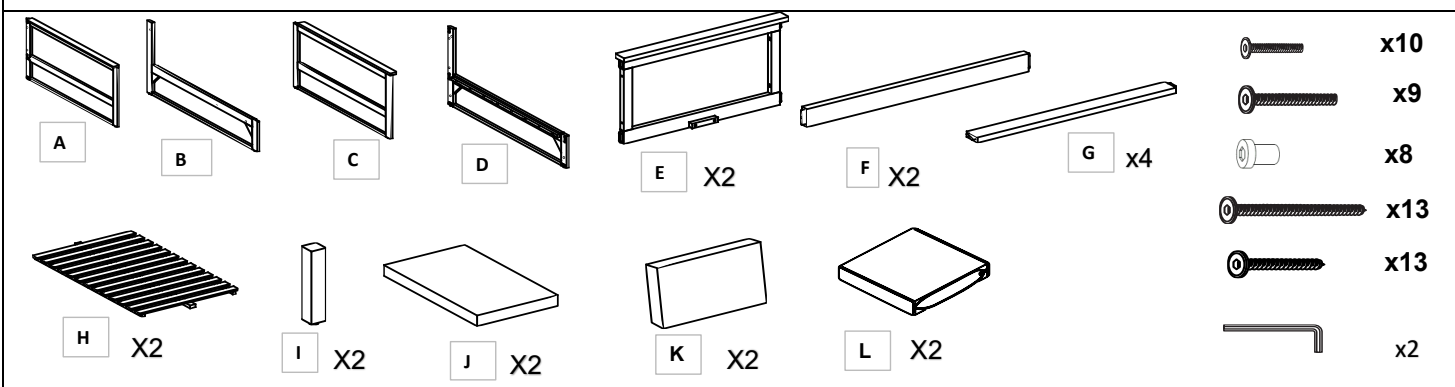

Before Beginning Assembly:



- Read instructions, cover to cover-



- Have 2 adults on hand for assembly-



- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



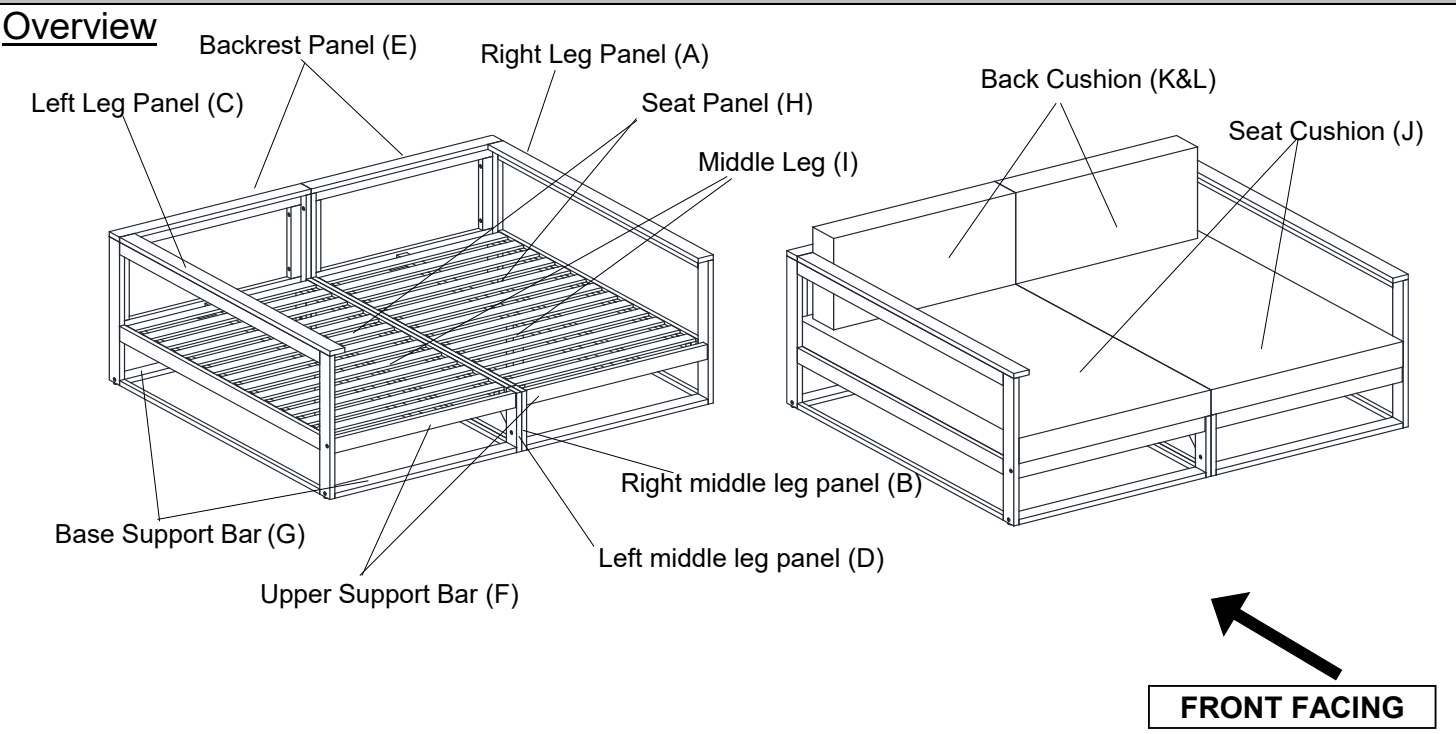
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



- Save all packaging until finished-

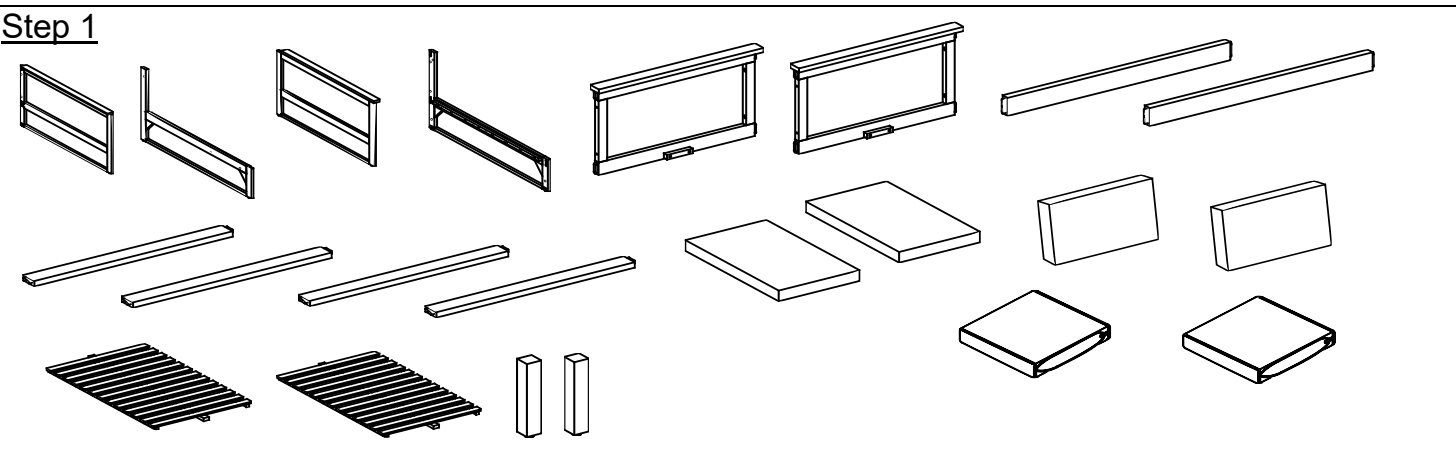
Assembly Steps

Overview



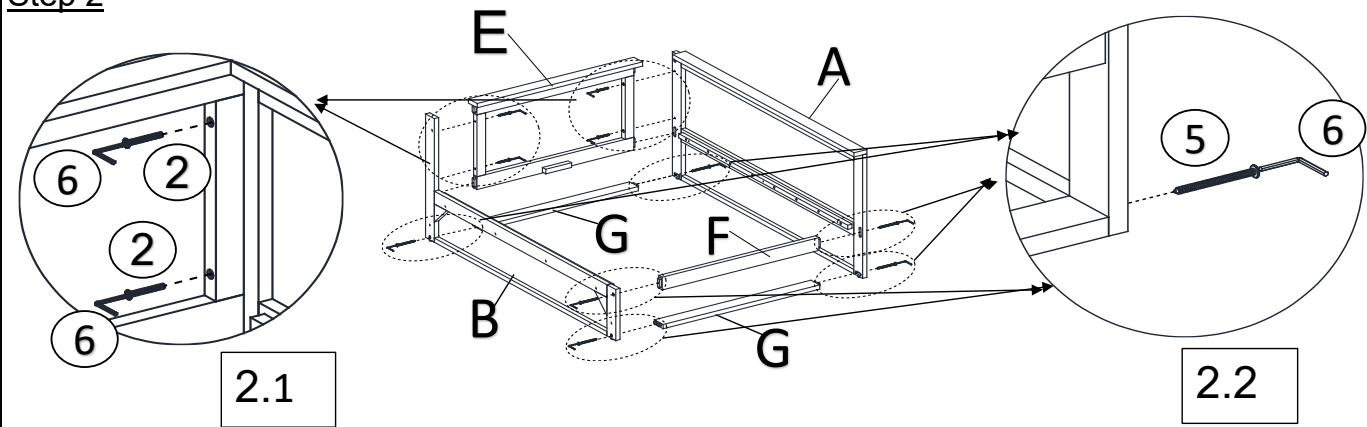
This Daybed has multiple parts and may require up to 60 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Daybed, the above picture is provided to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

Step 2



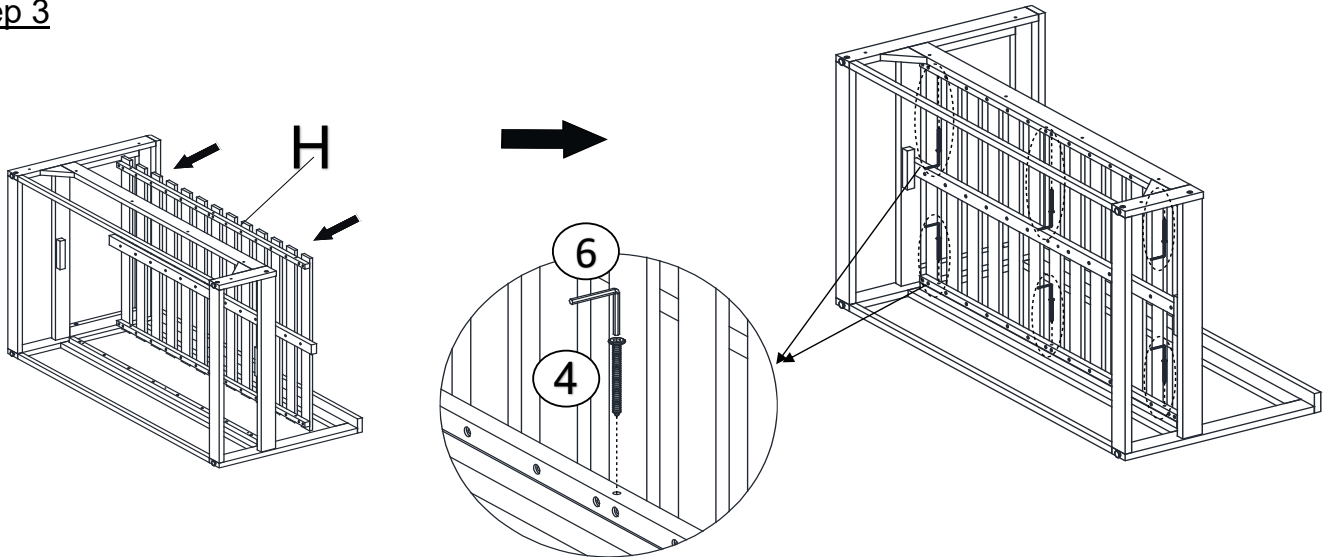
Place the Right Leg Panel (A), the Right Middle Leg Panel (B), the Backrest Panel (E), the Upper Support Bar (F) and the Base Support Bar (G) as shown in the picture above onto a clean soft surface to avoid any scratches or damage to the product. With assistance from your adult partner(s):

2.1 Attach the Backrest Panel (E) to the Right Leg Panel (A) and the Right Middle Leg Panel (B) by using Bolt (②) and Allen Wrench (⑥) as shown above

2.2 Attach the Upper Support Bar (F) to the Right Leg Panel (A) and the Right Middle Leg Panel (B) by using Screw (⑤) and Allen Wrench (⑥). Then attach the Base Support Bar (G) to the Right Leg Panel (A) and the Right Middle Leg Panel (B) by using Screw (⑤) and Allen Wrench (⑥) as shown above

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts and Screws at this time.

Step 3

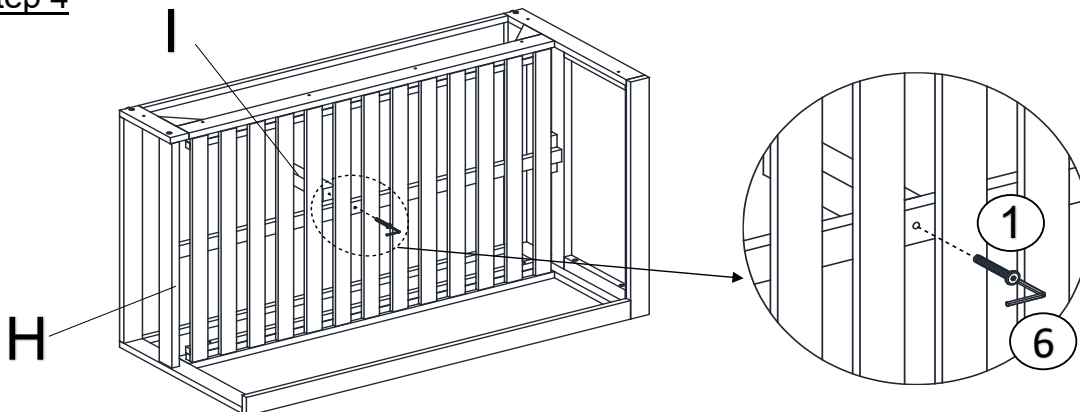


Place the assembled parts in step 2 and the Seat Panel (H) at an angle, as shown above

Attach the Seat Panel (H) to the assembled parts in step 2 by using Screw (④) and Allen Wrench (⑥) as shown above

DO NOT fully tighten the Screws at this time.

Step 4

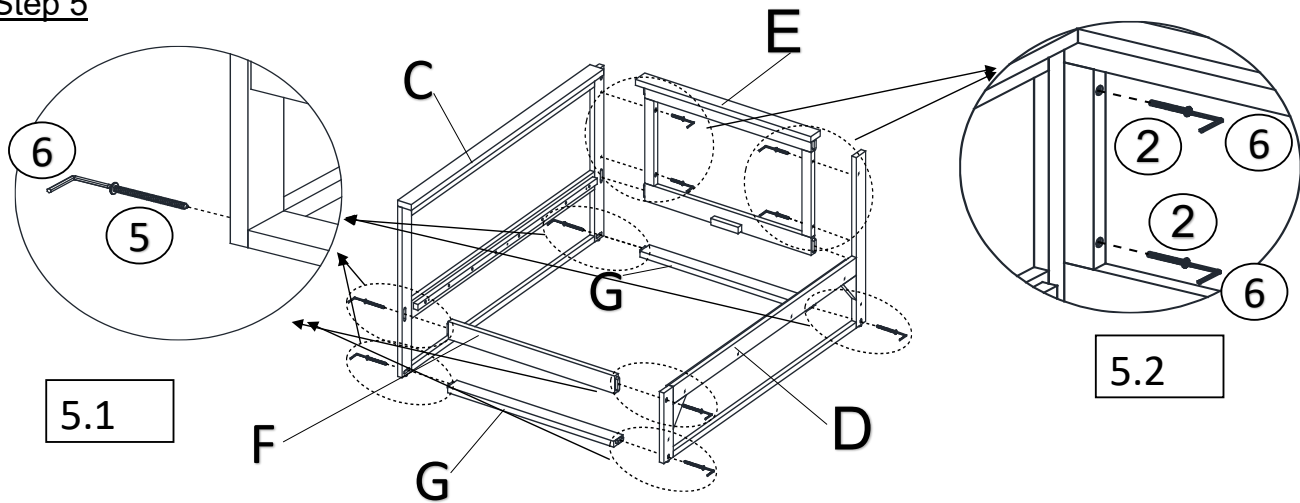


Place the assembled parts in step 3 and the Middle Leg (I) at an angle, as shown above

Attach the Middle Leg (I) to the assembled part in step 3 by using Bolt (①) and Allen Wrench (⑥)

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts at this time.

Step 5



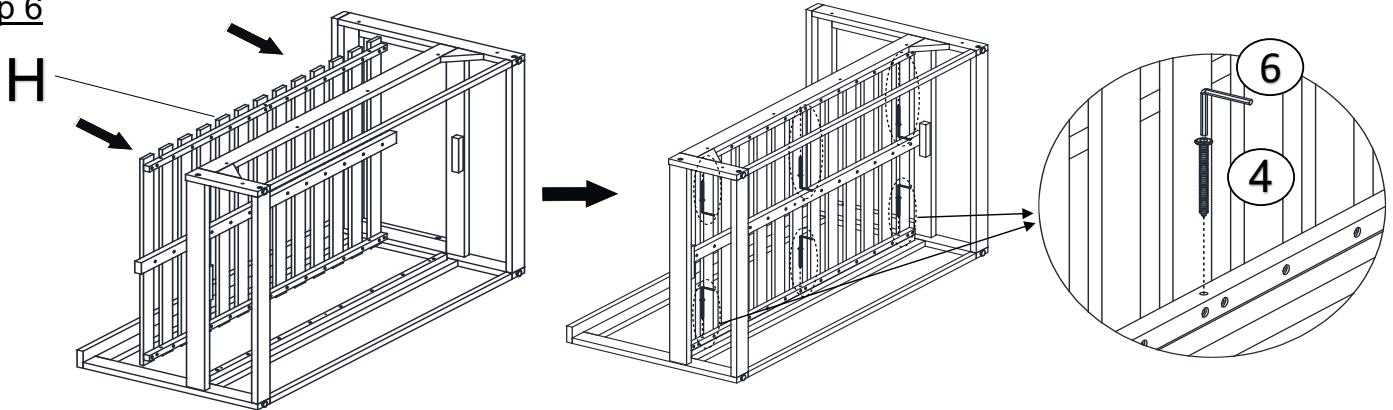
Place the Left Leg Panel (C), the Left Middle Leg Panel (D), the Backrest Panel (E), the Upper Support Bar (F) and the Base Support Bar (G) as shown above

5.1 Attach the Upper Support Bar (F) to the Left Leg Panel (C) and the Left Middle Leg Panel (D) by using Screw (⑤) and Allen Wrench (⑥). Then attach the Base Support Bar (G) to the Left Leg Panel (C) and the Left Middle Leg Panel (D) by using Screw (⑤) and Allen Wrench (⑥) as shown above

5.2 Attach the Backrest Panel (E) to the Left Leg Panel (C) and the Left Middle Leg Panel (D) by using Bolt (②) and Allen Wrench (⑥) as shown above

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts and Screws at this time.

Step 6

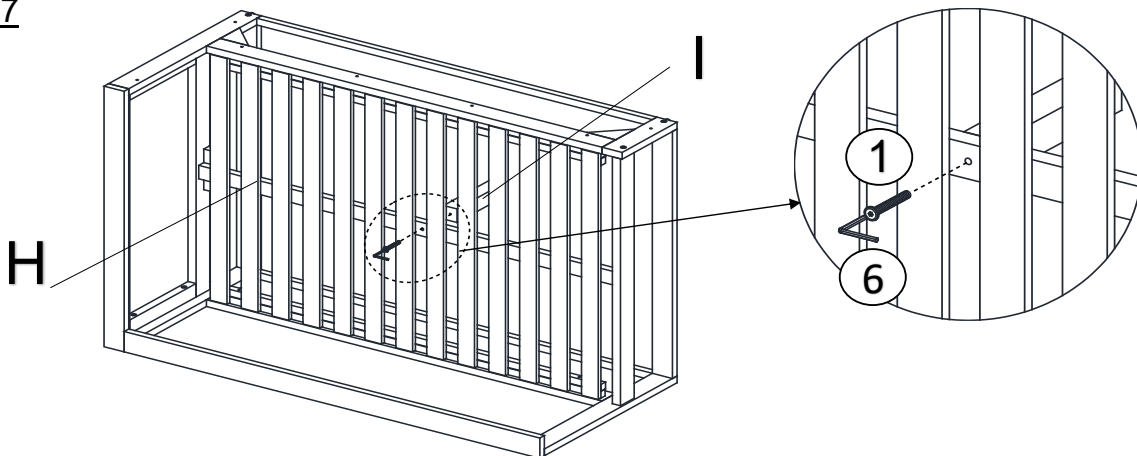


Place the assembled parts in step 5 and the Seat Panel (H) at an angle, as shown above

Attach the Seat Panel (H) to the assembled parts in step 5 by using Screw (④) and Allen Wrench (⑥) as shown above

DO NOT fully tighten the Screws at this time.

Step 7

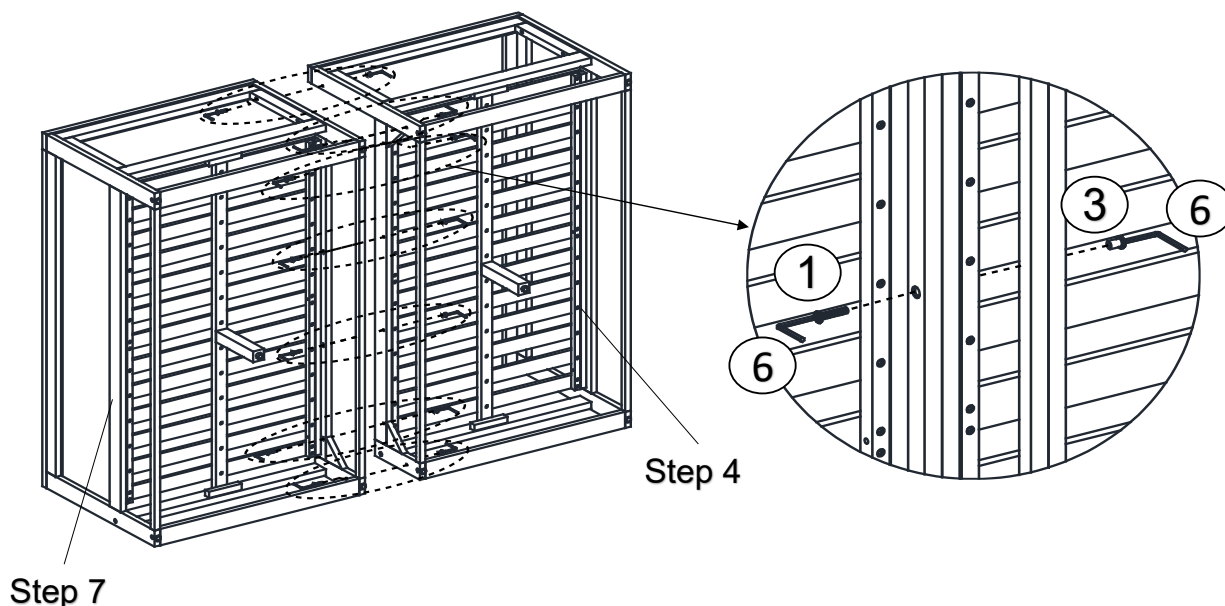


Place the assembled parts in step 6 and the Middle Leg (I) at an angle, as shown above

Attach the Middle Leg (I) to the assembled part in step 6 by using Bolt (①) and Allen Wrench (⑥) as shown above

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts at this time.

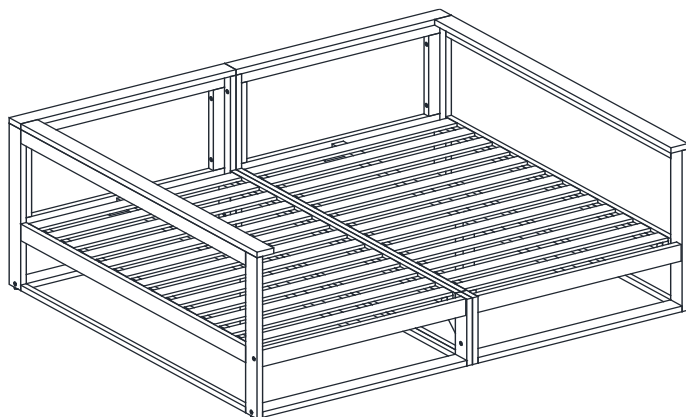
Step 8



Place the assemble in step 7 and the assembled in step 4 as shown above
Attach the assemble in step 7 to the assembled in step 4 by using Bolt (①), Sleeve Nut (③) and Allen Wrench (⑥) as shown above

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts and Sleeve Nuts at this time.

Step 9



Turn the Daybed right side up.

Inspect the Daybed and make sure all parts are adequately connected

In a sequential manner, tighten all Screws and Bolts at all joints.

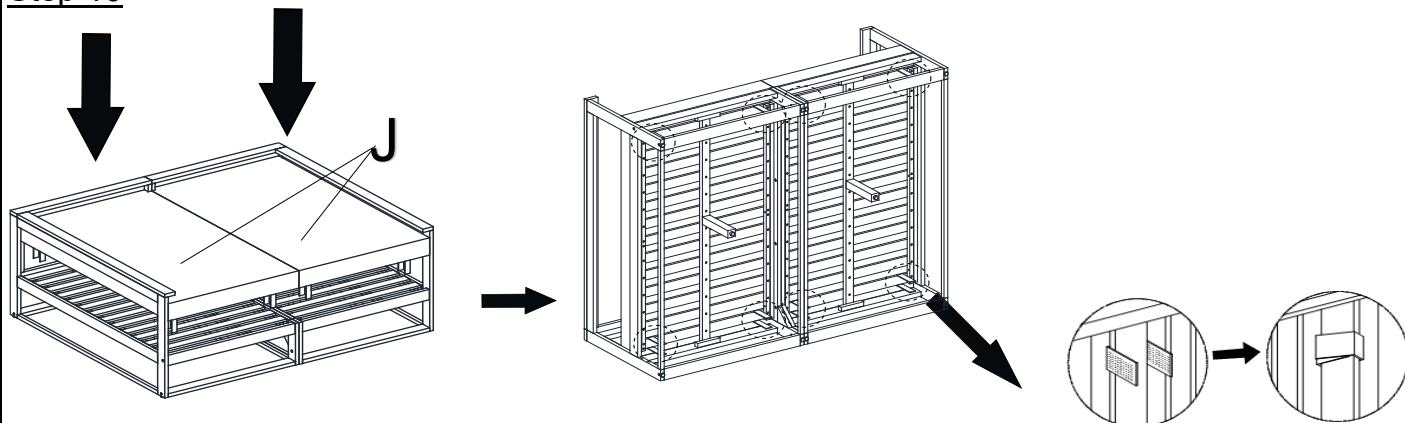
With assistance from your adult partner, adjust the Levelers to the desired height to avoid wobbles.

CAUTION: When tightening these screws and bolts, tighten sequentially.

DO NOT tighten any screw or bolt fully and then move towards the next one. This could cause the frame to warp.

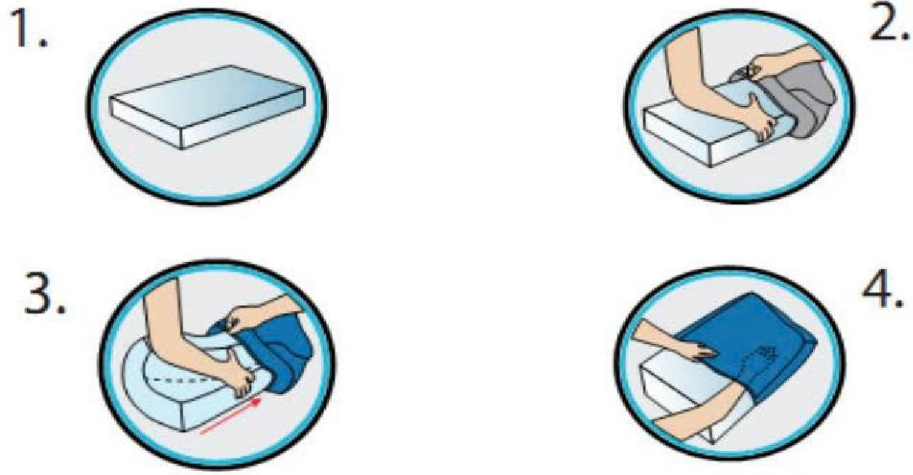
WARNING!! IF THE DAYBED IS NOT STABLE , IT COULD LEAD TO DAMAGING THE PRODUCT.

Step 10



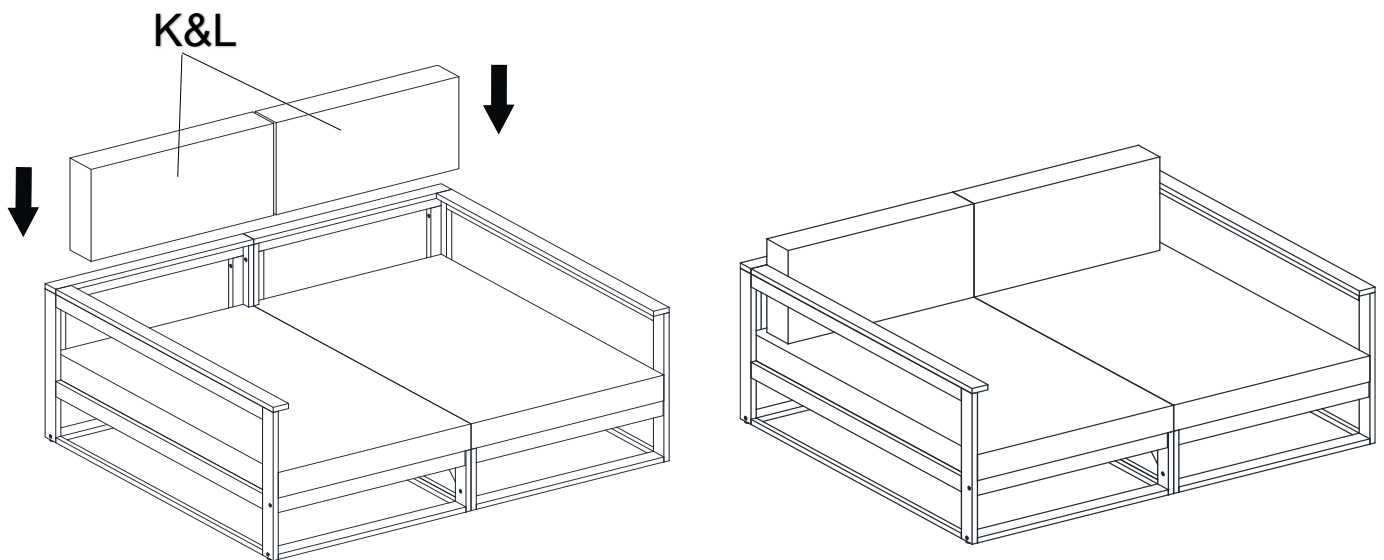
Place Daybed Seat Cushion (J) into the Daybed and affix the magic tape straps around the 3 Seater as shown above.

Step 11



- 10.1 Remove plastic bag to decompress white Fiber Seat Cushion (K).
- 10.2 Unzip Back Cushion Cover (L).
- 10.3 Insert Fiber Back Cushion (K) into matching Back Cushion Cover (L)
- 10.4 Adjust/smooth out cover and cushion before zipping pillow closed.

Step 12



Place the Back Cushion in step 10 into the daybed
Your Daybed is ready to be used.
This Daybed can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

- What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
