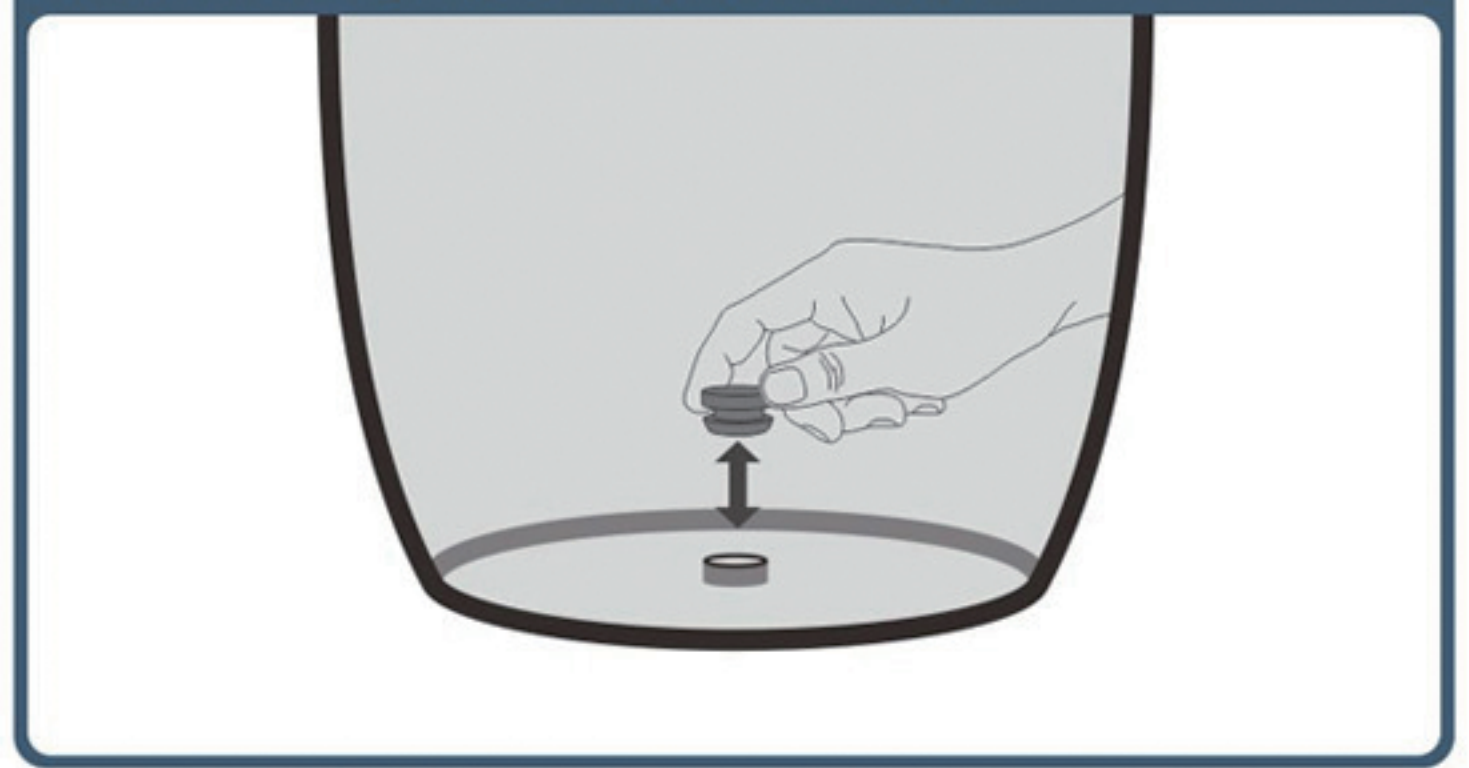

PLANTING USE ONLY

Do not use as a fire pit, candle holder, grill, heater, burner, fountain, pond, or water feature. Do not expose it to fire or flame or use it for cooking, heating, or holding or storing.



INDOOR LEAK CHECK

Insert the included rubber drain plug securely from inside the planter. Test with water and confirm there is no leakage before indoor placement. Use a protective tray underneath.



DAMAGED PRODUCT

If cracked, broken, or chipped, stop using it. Wear protective gloves when moving it and protect your hands. Lift from the base with adequate assistance.



DO NOT MODIFY OR REPURPOSE

Do not drill, cut, modify, or repurpose the planter. Doing so may cause cracking or damage and create a risk of injury.

1. **Placement:** Position the planter in a location that complements your decor and supports the plant's sunlight requirements.



2. **Soil Filling:** Fill with suitable potting mix, leaving room at the top to avoid overflow.



3. **Planting:** Place your plant in the planter, ensuring it is centered and stable.



4. **Watering:** Water the plant as required, ensuring excess water can drain through the hole.

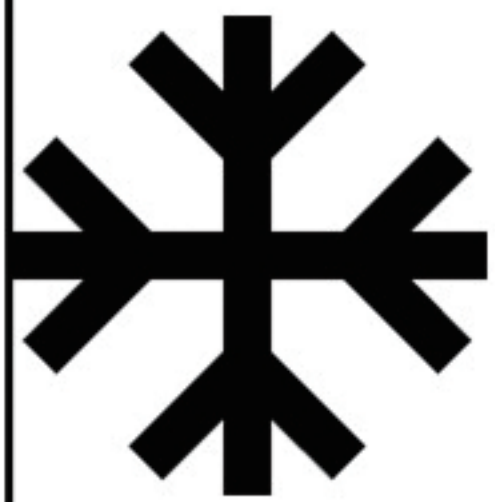

Q7: How should the drain plugs be placed in the pot? The inside surface is not flush around the hole, and I'm worried the plug will not form a complete seal.

A7: For the installation of the drain plugs, we recommend inserting them from the inside of the planter. There is no need to worry about the interior surface not being flush with the hole, as the drain plugs are made of rubber, which is flexible. They are designed to fit snugly into the hole and provide a secure seal despite any slight irregularities.

Q8: What measures have been taken to ensure the durability and reliability of the packaging for your concrete planter during transportation?

A8: Our package has passed the ISTA 6 test, which includes a series of rigorous simulations of real-world shipping conditions such as drops, vibrations, and compressions. This ensures that our concrete flower pots are well-protected and will arrive in perfect condition, providing peace of mind to our customers.
